FUNDING SUMMARY

Provides an FY 2022 General Fund supplemental appropriation of \$75,000 and an FY 2022 Veterans License Fee Fund supplemental appropriation of \$75,000 to the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA). The appropriations provide a grant to support the christening and commissioning of the U.S.S. Iowa. The IEDA may use up to 5.0% (\$7,500) of the moneys appropriated to administer the funds. Unencumbered or unobligated moneys appropriated by this Bill will revert to the General Fund on June 30, 2024.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Bill is effective upon enactment.
