MAJOR INCREASES/DECREASES/TRANSFERS OF EXISTING PROGRAMS

Child Care Assistance Eligibility Increase: Increases the proposed income limit for State Child Care Assistance (CCA) eligibility from 155.0% of the federal poverty level (FPL) to 160.0% of the FPL.

Page 1, Line 1

Detail: The current income limit for CCA eligibility is 145.0% of the FPL.

Fiscal Impact: Increasing the CCA eligibility limit from 145.0% of the FPL to 160.0% of the FPL at the current reimbursement rate will increase annual expenditures by \$13.2 million. Increasing the childcare provider reimbursement rates as detailed in this Bill for those currently enrolled will increase annual expenditures by \$10.9 million. Increasing the reimbursement rates in addition to the increased eligibility will increase annual expenditures by an additional \$1.6 million. The total annual fiscal impact of increasing the CCA eligibility limit 160.0% of the FPL and increasing reimbursement rates is \$25.7 million.
