FUNDING SUMMARY

Provides that of the \$11.7 million Skilled Worker and Job Creation Fund appropriation the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA) received in FY 2024 for the <u>High Quality Jobs Program</u>, \$300,000 will be allocated for the <u>Certified Sites Program</u>. Moneys allocated must be used to certify sites in counties with a population of less than 50,000 and to certify at least two sites in each congressional district.
