Section 1.NEW SECTION 16.230 DEFINITIONS. 1 1 2 1 As used in this part, unless the context otherwise requires: 1. "Financial assistance" means assistance provided only 1 3 4 from the funds, rights, and assets legally available to the 1 5 authority and includes but is not limited to assistance in the 1 6 form of low-interest loans. 1 2. "Fund" means the jobs and infrastructure revolving fund 1 7 1 8 created in section 16.231. 3. "Program" means the jobs and infrastructure program 1 9 1 10 established in section 16.232. 4. "Vertical infrastructure" means land acquisition and 1 11 1 12 construction, all appurtenant structures, utilities, and 1 13 site development. "Vertical infrastructure" does not include 1 14 routine, recurring maintenance or operational expenses, the 1 15 acquisition of agricultural land as defined in section 6A.21 1 16 without the consent of the owner of the property, or leasing of 1 17 an appurtenant structure or utility without a lease-purchase 1 18 agreement. 1 19 Sec. 2.NEW SECTION 16.231 JOBS AND INFRASTRUCTURE 1 20 **REVOLVING FUND.** 1. A jobs and infrastructure revolving fund is created 1 21 1 22 within the state treasury under the control of the authority 1 23 for the purpose of providing financial assistance to government 1 24 subdivisions for vertical infrastructure projects. Any

Provides definitions.

Creates the Jobs and Infrastructure Revolving Fund under the control of the Iowa Finance Authority (IFA). The Fund may be used to provide financial assistance to government subdivisions for vertical infrastructure projects. Interest or earnings on moneys in the Fund are credited to the Fund.

Allows any unexpended moneys in the Fund at the end of a fiscal year to remain available for expenditure until the close of the next fiscal year.

Allows the IFA to use up to 5.00% of moneys in the Fund for administrative costs.

Creates the Jobs and Infrastructure Program to award financial assistance from the Fund to eligible government subdivisions for vertical infrastructure projects.

Requires a government subdivision to meet the following requirements to be eligible for the Program:

- Demonstrate the government subdivision's ability to obtain financial support from private sources for at least 50.0% of aggregate costs for the vertical infrastructure project.
- Demonstrate that the government subdivision's vertical infrastructure project will create or retain jobs that meet requirements prescribed by the IFA.

Requires eligible government subdivisions to submit applications for the Program in a manner prescribed through administrative rules by the IFA.

Requires the IFA to adopt administrative rules to implement the Jobs and Infrastructure Program.
