BILL SUMMARY

Increases the annual reimbursement limit from the Second Injury Fund to the Attorney General's Office for services provided related to the Fund from \$450,000 to \$900,000.

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Senate File 2467 provides for the following changes to the Code of Iowa.

1 6 attorney general shall be reimbursed up to ~~four hundred fifty~~
1 7 nine hundred thousand dollars annually from the fund for
1 8 services provided related to the fund. The commissioner of
1 9 insurance shall consider the reimbursement to the attorney
1 10 general as an outstanding liability when making a determination
1 11 of funding availability under section 85.65A, subsection 2.

CODE: Increases the annual reimbursement limit from the Second Injury Fund to the Attorney General's Office for services provided related to the Fund from \$450,000 to \$900,000.

NOTE: The FY 2025 ending balance in the Second Injury Fund was \$8,045,719.
