EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

HOUSE FILE 2758

CHILDHOOD CANCER RESEARCH, APPROPRIATION BILL

NEW PROGRAMS, SERVICES, OR ACTIVITIES

Requires the appropriated moneys to be used for pediatric cancer research conducted at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, including both laboratory research and clinical trials, and prohibits use for administrative, overhead, or unrelated expenses.

FUNDING FOR PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS

Establishes a standing General Fund appropriation to the State Board of Regents beginning in FY 2027 equal to \$1 per Iowa resident, based on the most recent U.S. Census population estimate, not to exceed \$3.0 million annually.

STUDIES AND INTENT

Requires the Board of Regents to submit an annual report to the Governor and General Assembly detailing the use of funds in the prior fiscal year.
