FISCAL IMPACT

- Creates a new Private Water Supply System Account in the Water Quality Protection Fund. Fees from private well construction permits and private well contractor certification will be deposited into this account.
- Beginning July 1, 2003, counties will be required to forward \$25 of the fee collected for the issuance of private well construction permits and private well contractor certification to the Department of Natural Resources.
- Appropriates funds from this Account to the Department of Natural Resources for educational programs, technical assistance, and enforcement activities related to private well programs.
- Fees collected are estimated to be approximately \$118,000 in FY 2004 and subsequent years.
