HOUSE FILE 807 FY 2006 JUDICIAL BRANCH APPROPRIATIONS BILL

FUNDING SUMMARY	• Appropriates a total of \$120.1 million from the General Fund to the Judicial Branch. The Judicial Branch has 1,817.9 FTE positions, which are not appropriated in this Bill. This is no change in funding or FTE positions compared to the estimated net FY 2005 appropriation.
CONTINGENT FY 2005 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION	• Makes a contingent appropriation for FY 2005 of \$600,000 to be used for administration and operations. The funds appropriated in this Section are contingent upon the receipt of Microsoft anti-trust settlement money by the General Fund. (Page 1, Line 21)
INTENT LANGUAGE AND REQUIRED REPORTS	• Specifies that the Offices of the Clerks of District Court operate in all 99 counties and be accessible to the public as much as reasonably possible. (Page 2, Line 18)
	• Requires the Judicial Branch to study the best practices and efficiencies of each judicial district. The report is due to the General Assembly by December 15, 2005. (Page 2, Line 23)
	• Requires the Judicial Branch to report to the General Assembly by January 1, 2006, regarding the revenues and expenditures for the Enhanced Court Collections Fund and the Court Technology and Modernization Fund. The report shall include revenues and expenditures for FY 2005 and planned expenditures for FY 2006. (Page 3, Line 16)
	• Requires the State Court Administrator to approve all Clerk of Court appointments. (Page 4, Line 1)
