EXECUTIVE SUMMARY NOTES ON BILLS AND AMENDMENTS

SENATE FILE 2153 PUBLIC HEALTH DISASTER BILL

PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY OR DISASTER FUNDING

- Permits the Department of Public Health, in conjunction with the Governor, to provide financial assistance to local governments, from funds appropriated to the Department that are not otherwise encumbered, in the event of a public health emergency or disaster that poses an imminent threat to the public health, safety, and welfare.
- Permits the Governor to issue an Executive Order to provide available moneys from the General Fund for the purpose of a public health emergency or disaster if the Department does not have sufficient unencumbered funds.

FISCAL IMPACT

• The fiscal impact of assisting local governments in the event of a public health emergency or disaster cannot be determined, as the cost would depend on the type and severity of the emergency or disaster-related event.
