GRANTS ENTERPRISE MANAGEMENT APPROPRIATION**

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- The 2003 General Assembly approved Senate File 438 (Grant Enterprise Management System Act) that established the Office of Grants Enterprise Management within the Department of Management. The Office was created to develop and administer a system to track, identify, advocate for, and coordinate federal funds received by the State, through the work of a facilitator appointed by the Director of the Department of Management.
- The Office is funded by a standing limited appropriation from indirect cost reimbursements resulting from receipt of federal funds. The appropriation is based on the increase in indirect cost reimbursements compared to FY 2003, not to exceed \$125,000.
- The Bill removes the provision that the appropriation to the Office be limited to the increase in indirect cost reimbursements. Instead, the Bill provides a \$125,000 standing appropriation from indirect cost reimbursements to the Department of Management for the Office.
- The Bill also provides that an additional appropriation of \$35,000 for FY 2007 and FY 2008 to provide grant identification and writing assistance to State agencies.
- This Bill takes effect July 1, 2006.
