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# AGRICULTURE AND NATURAL RESOURCES APPROPRIATIONS BILL CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT

**SENATE FILE 494** 

**Funding Summary:** Senate File 494, as proposed by the Conference Committee, appropriates a total of \$43.1 million from the General Fund and 1,569.0 FTE positions for FY 2016. This is no change in funding and an increase of 96.5 FTE positions compared to estimated FY 2015. Senate File 494 also appropriates \$89.0 million from other funds. This is an increase of \$1.2 million compared to estimated FY 2015. Funding for FY 2017 is appropriated at 50.0% of the FY 2016 level with the exceptions of:

- No action is taken on REAP for FY 2017. This leaves the \$20.0 million standing appropriation in place for FY 2017.
- No appropriation for the Data Collection Program at Iowa State University as the \$1.2 million for FY 2016 is one-time funding.

**FUNDING SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS:** The Conference Committee recommends the House recede from amendment S-3157, and that Senate 494 as amended, passed, and reprinted by the Senate be amended as follows:

Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship (DALS): General Fund appropriations and FTE position changes:

Water Quality Initiative FTE Positions – 0.0 FTEs for FY 2016 and FY 2017.

**Department of Natural Resources (DNR):** General Fund appropriations:

- Floodplain Management Program \$1,950,000 for FY 2016.
- Forestry Health Management Program \$500,000 for FY 2016.

#### **Environment First Fund (EFF):**

- Soil and Water Conservation \$2,700,000 for FY 2016.
- Volunteers Keepers of the Land Program \$0 for FY 2016.
- Forestry Health Management Program \$0 for FY 2016 as the Program will be funded with a \$500,000 General Fund appropriation.

Supplemental General Fund FY 2015 Appropriation: Removes the supplemental FY 2015 to the DALS for a study on Avian Influenza.

#### Language Summary:

Note: This language summary represents major language provisions and should not be considered an all-inclusive comprehensive listing.

#### Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship (DALS):

- Changes the name of the Soil Conservation Division to the Division of Soil Conservation and Water Quality as directed in <a href="HF 634">HF 634</a> (FY 2016 DALS Departmental Act).
- Removes language related to salaries and support for the elimination of the Water Quality Initiative FTE positions for FY 2016 and FY 2017.

**Department of Natural Resources (DNR):** Adds Park Managers, in addition to Park Rangers, as job positions not impacted by the 50.0 FTE positions allocated for maintenance and upkeep at State Parks.

**SENATE FILE 494** 

**Blufflands Protection and Revolving Fund:** Reestablishes the Blufflands Protection and Revolving Fund that is repealed on July 1, 2015, and changes the Fund repeal date to July 1, 2030.

Avian Influenza Waste Disposal: Exempts an entity with a 28E agreement from outside claims when disposing of special waste received from a government unit in response to a disaster emergency. Also requires a 28E entity that accepts avian flu waste for landfill disposal that receives reimbursement from the federal Department of Agriculture to provide a report to the General by January 1, 2016, that summarizes total revenues and expenditures related to the disposal of the waste.

#### **Effective Dates:**

- The Blufflands Protection and Revolving Fund provision is effective on enactment.
- The claim exemption for a 28E entity disposing of avian influenza waste is effective on enactment.
