TOTAL FUNDING: Senate File 2314, as amended by S-5115, appropriates a total of \$350.5 million to the Department of Transportation (DOT).

House amendment S-5115 makes the following funding changes to SF 2314, as passed by the Senate:

- Reduces the Primary Road Fund appropriation to the Operations budget unit by \$280,000 for FY 2012.
- Reduces the Primary Road Fund appropriation to the Highway budget unit by \$800,000 to realize potential utility savings for FY 2012.
- Reduces the Road Use Tax Fund appropriation for scale replacement projects by \$200,000 for FY 2013.
- Reduces the Primary Road Fund appropriation for costs associated with the production of State transportation maps by \$161,333 for FY 2013.

DETAIL: This is a deappropriation for FY 2012.

Reduces the Road Use Tax Fund appropriation for scale replacement projects by \$200,000 for FY 2013.

DETAIL: The appropriation in SF 2314, as passed by the Senate, reflected the average cost for replacing one large 90-foot scale and one smaller 40-foot scale.

Reduces the total Primary Road Fund appropriation (as passed by the Senate) for costs associated with the production of State transportation maps by \$161,333 for FY 2013.

The deappropriations to the Operations and Highways budgets are effective on enactment.
