Language Differences:

- Office of Drug Control Policy: The Senate version makes an appropriation to the Office of Drug Control Policy or its successor agency. The House version does not include the successor agency reference.
- **Insurance Division Carryforward:** The House version provides for the carryforward of Insurance Division funds to be used for the relocation of the Division's office. The Senate version does not provide for the carryforward.
- Expenses Related to Nuclear Generation: The House provides a contingent appropriation to the Utilities Division from the Commerce Revolving Fund for expenses related to nuclear generation. The Senate version does not.
- Secretary of State Filing Fees: The House allows the Secretary of State the discretion to refund the \$50 fee for certificates of organization and the \$100 fee for applications for certificates of authority for limited liability corporations. The Senate version does not.
- Medicaid Fraud Fund Transfer to the Health Care Trust Fund: The House provides for the transfer of Medicaid Fraud Fund funds to the Health Care Trust Fund at the beginning of FY 2014. The Senate version does not address the transfer of funds from the Medicaid Fraud Fund to the Health Care Trust Fund.
- **Effective Date:** The House version provides that the transfer of Medicaid Fraud Fund funds to the Health Care Trust Fund is effective July 1, 2013. The Senate version does not provide any effective dates.
- Retroactive Applicability: The House version provides that the Insurance Division carryforward is retroactive to July 1, 2011. The Senate version does not provide any retroactive dates.
- Medicaid Fraud Fund Repeal of FY 2013 Appropriation: The Senate repeals the FY 2013 appropriation to the Department of Inspections and Appeals from the Medicaid Fraud Fund. The House provides additional appropriations from the Fund.
