Language Differences:

- Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship (DALS) General Fund appropriations: House appropriates \$1.6 million for operations for the following:
 - \$352,500 for administrative expenses in the Soil Conservation Division.
 - \$950,000 for salary increases and related expenses.
 - o \$110,000 and 2.00 FTE positions for Soil Conservation Technicians.
 - \$118,000 and 2.00 FTE positions for Gas Pump Inspectors.
 - o \$105,000 and 1.00 FTE positions for a State Veterinarian.
- Department of Natural Resources operations: The Senate requires 30 to 32 full-time Park Rangers.
- Fish and Game Protection Fund:
 - o The Senate requires 84 full-time Conservation Officers.
 - o The House allows use of unappropriated funds for salary adjustments and the Senate does not.
 - o The Senate extends purchase date for mobile radios to June 30, 2013.
- Farmers Demonstration Program: The House allocates \$400,000 to the Iowa Soybean Association and the Senate allocates \$370,000.
- Environment First Fund: The House strikes language that allows DALS to use a percentage of Environment First Fund (EFF) appropriations for administration.
- Loess Hills Development and Conservation Fund: The Senate does not allocate money for the Hungry Canyons Program.
- Southern Iowa Conservation Authority: The Senate does not fund this Program.
- Resource Enhancement and Protection (REAP) Fund:
 - The Senate notwithstands the General Fund standing appropriation of \$20.0 million and appropriates \$12.0 million from the EFF. The House appropriates \$12.0 million from the General Fund in HF 2465 (Standing Appropriation Bill).
 - o The House adds language related to the REAP appropriation:
 - o Specifies the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) can use funds in the Open Spaces Account for State Park Maintenance and operations if the allocation is greater than \$4.2 million.
 - Specifies DALS can use funds in the Soil and Water Enhancement Account for urban conservation practices if the allocation is greater than \$3.0 million.
