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FUNDING SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS:

Funding Summary: Senate File 2324, as approved by the Conference Committee, appropriates a total of \$99.3 million for FY 2017 and \$11.0 million for FY 2018 from the following funds:

FY 2017: Appropriates a net total of \$99.3 million for FY 2017 from the following sources:

- \$82.4 million from the Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund (RIIF).
- \$236,000 from the Technology Reinvestment Fund.
- \$16.7 million from the State Bond Repayment Fund.

FY 2018: Appropriates a total of \$11.0 million from the RIIF.

General Fund: Eliminates a \$17.5 million appropriation from the General Fund to the Technology Reinvestment Fund for FY 2017.

NOTE: The above funding levels reflect new appropriations and changes to previously enacted appropriations that are included in SF 2324.

Previously enacted appropriations from prior legislative sessions or standing appropriations are not reflected in these funding levels.

HIGHLIGHTS OF APPROPRIATIONS AND PROVISIONS AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT:

Voter Registration System Update: \$300,000 from the RIIF.

o Polk County Justice Center: \$6.7 million from the State Bond Repayment Fund.

Other Provisions

- Allocates \$100,000 from the appropriation for major maintenance costs associated with monuments on the Capitol Complex that do not have funds set-aside for ongoing maintenance.
- Requires that health, life, and safety projects at the lowa Law Enforcement Academy (ILEA) be given priority for funding from the major maintenance appropriation.
- Allocates \$225,000 to the Iowa Nutrient Research Center at ISU for nutrient water monitoring network technology and equipment. Specifies that not more than \$150,000 of the allocated funds be used for operating costs of the network.
- Allocates funds from the appropriation for Capitol Dome repairs for costs associated with the installation of outdoor lighting at the State Capitol Building.

- Transfers \$3.0 million from funds appropriated to the Department of Human Services in FY 2012 for Medicaid technology upgrades. The Department was appropriated a total of \$14.4 million from the Technology Reinvestment Fund over four-year period during the 2011 Legislative Session in HF 648 (FY 2012 Infrastructure Appropriations Act) for technology upgrades. The appropriations included \$3.5 million for FY 2012, \$4.7 million for FY 2013, \$4.3 million for FY 2014, and \$1.9 million for FY 2015. The \$3.0 million transferred to the RIIF in this bill was scheduled to revert to the Technology Reinvestment Fund at the close of FY 2016.
- Extends the reversion date for a \$320,000 FY 2013 Technology Reinvestment Fund appropriation to lowa Public Television for the purchase of high powered transmitting tubes used for the digital transmission of television signals. This bill extends the date that funds will revert from FY 2016 to FY 2018.
- Reduces the FY 2017 RIIF appropriation to the UI for the Pharmacy Building renovation by \$6.0 million and increases the FY 2018 appropriation by the same amount. The UI was appropriated a total of \$66.3 million over a four-year period for the Pharmacy Building during the 2014 Legislative Session in SF 2349 (FY 2015 Infrastructure Appropriations Act). The appropriations included \$2.0 million for FY 2015, \$13.0 million for FY 2016, \$29.0 million for FY 2017, and \$22.3 million for FY 2018. This bill reduces the FY 2017 appropriation to \$23.0 million and increases the FY 2018 appropriation to \$28.3 million.
- Reduces the FY 2017 RIIF appropriation to ISU for construction of a bioscience facility by \$4.0 million and increases the FY 2018 appropriation by the same amount. Iowa State University was appropriated a total of \$52.0 million over a four-year period for the bioscience facility during the 2014 Legislative Session in SF 2349 (FY 2015 Infrastructure Appropriations Act). The appropriations included \$2.0 million for FY 2015, \$11.0 million for FY 2016, \$19.5 million for FY 2017, and \$19.5 million for FY 2018. This bill reduces the FY 2017 appropriation to \$15.5 million and increases the FY 2018 appropriation to \$23.5 million.
- Amends an FY 2016 appropriation requirement associated with a grant to expand a Polk County emergency youth shelter. The amended
 language allows the grant recipient to be reimbursed for infrastructure costs incurred during a prior fiscal year. The grant recipient may also use
 expenditures and in-kind contributions incurred in any fiscal year as matching funds.
- Amends the Lake Restoration Program and makes the following changes:
 - Defines public shallow lake and wetland and makes these entities eligible to receive Lake Restoration Funding.
 - o Requires the Lake Restoration projects to contribute to the DNR's fish and wildlife conservation plans. Requires the DNR to maintain a list of up to five public shallow lakes or wetlands in addition to the list of 35 significant public lakes.
 - o Requires the DNR to meet with stakeholders in communities near the lakes listed on the annual list.
 - o Decreases the mean depth of lakes that will be dredged from 10 to eight feet.
 - Requires the DNR to seek public comment prior to submitting the annual Lake Restoration Plan and Report to the General Assembly each year.
- Allocates any unobligated funds in the Prison Bonding Fund to the DOC for major maintenance projects. The unobligated funds in the Prison Bonding Fund total approximately \$163,000.

- Authorizes the Iowa Telecommunications and Technology Commission to enter into a contract for a network core upgrade project. The cost of the upgrade is anticipated to exceed the current contract limitation amount set pursuant to Iowa Code section 8D.11.
- Requires state agency budget requests for FY 2018 to specify whether requested funds will be used for state employee salaries and benefits.
- Specifies the intent of the General Assembly that future appropriations from the RIIF should be used, to the greatest extent possible, for public vertical infrastructure projects that involve major maintenance of state government facilities necessary for the proper functioning of state government.
