The I/3 Technical Support Bureau provides the strategic direction as well as the functional deployment and support of the Integrated Information for Iowa (I/3) system, which includes the enterprise accounting, procurement, and budget preparation functions for the state of Iowa. The support and network infrastructure is built on a software platform developed by CGI Technologies and Solutions, Inc. Preliminary design and planning work was completed to move the human resources and payroll functions to this new platform. The budgeting and planning processes are under way to complete the move of the human resources/payroll functions that will complete the I/3 system project. Currently, these functions remain on the state's old legacy platform.
