The Department of Management was created in 1986 by the General Assembly. The main functions of the department include developing and coordinating performance management systems, coordinating the strategic planning process of state government, developing and recommending policy initiatives to meet Iowa's needs, and establishing budget oversight procedures that ensure Iowa's fiscal integrity.

The department is comprised of the Budget and Finance Team and the Performance Results Team.

The department director is appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate, and serves at the Governor's pleasure. The director serves on various committees as directed by the Governor and the General Assembly, including the School Budget Review Committee, the Technology Governance Board, and the State Appeal Board.
