Historical information concerning redistricting in Iowa in 1981, 1991, 2001, and 2011, organized by year, as well as general information about redistricting in Iowa, under heading About Redistricting, can be found on this link. Information concerning redistricting during 2021 will be added to the 2021 link throughout the redistricting process. This information will include the receipt of population data from the U.S. Census Bureau, upcoming meetings of the Temporary Redistricting Advisory Commission, updated timetables, release dates for proposed redistricting plans, times and locations for public hearings, and other public information.

TEMPORARY REDISTRICTING ADVISORY COMMISSION

The initial meeting of the Temporary Redistricting Advisory Commission (TRAC) will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, February 22, 2021, by videoconference. The tentative agenda for the meeting consists of organizing, adopting rules, discussion of Commission duties and responsibilities, and selection of the fifth member, who serves as chairperson, of the Commission.
