## CONGRESSIONAL AND LEGISLATIVE REDISTRICTING PLAN ENACTED

On November 4, 2021, Iowa enacted both a congressional redistricting plan and a state legislative redistricting plan which shall be effective beginning with the elections in 2022 for the 118th U.S. Congress and the 90th Iowa General Assembly. On October 28, 2021, Senate File 621, the bill embodying the second proposed redistricting plan submitted by the Legislative Services Agency, passed the Iowa Senate on a vote of 48 to 1, and passed the Iowa House of Representatives on a vote of 93 to 2. Governor Kim Reynolds signed the bill into law on November 4, 2021.
