7 judicial officer's county of residence to conduct  
8 official judicial business."

2 1. Page 4, by inserting before line 22 the  
3 following:

4 "Sec. \_\_\_\_ . CIVIL TRIALS -- LOCATION.

5 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, for the  
6 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June  
7 30, 2010, if all parties in a case agree, a civil  
8 trial including a jury trial may take place in a  
9 county contiguous to the county with proper  
10 jurisdiction, even if the contiguous county is located  
11 in an adjacent judicial district or judicial election  
12 district. If the trial is moved pursuant to this  
13 section, court personnel shall treat the case as if a  
14 change of venue occurred. However, if a trial is  
15 moved to an adjacent judicial district or judicial  
16 election district, the judicial officers serving in  
17 the judicial district or judicial election district  
18 receiving the case shall preside over the case."

*Allows parties to a civil case, including a jury trial, to move the case to a contiguous county, even if it crosses a judicial district for one year. If the case is moved, the judicial officers in the judicial district that receives the case will preside over the case.*
