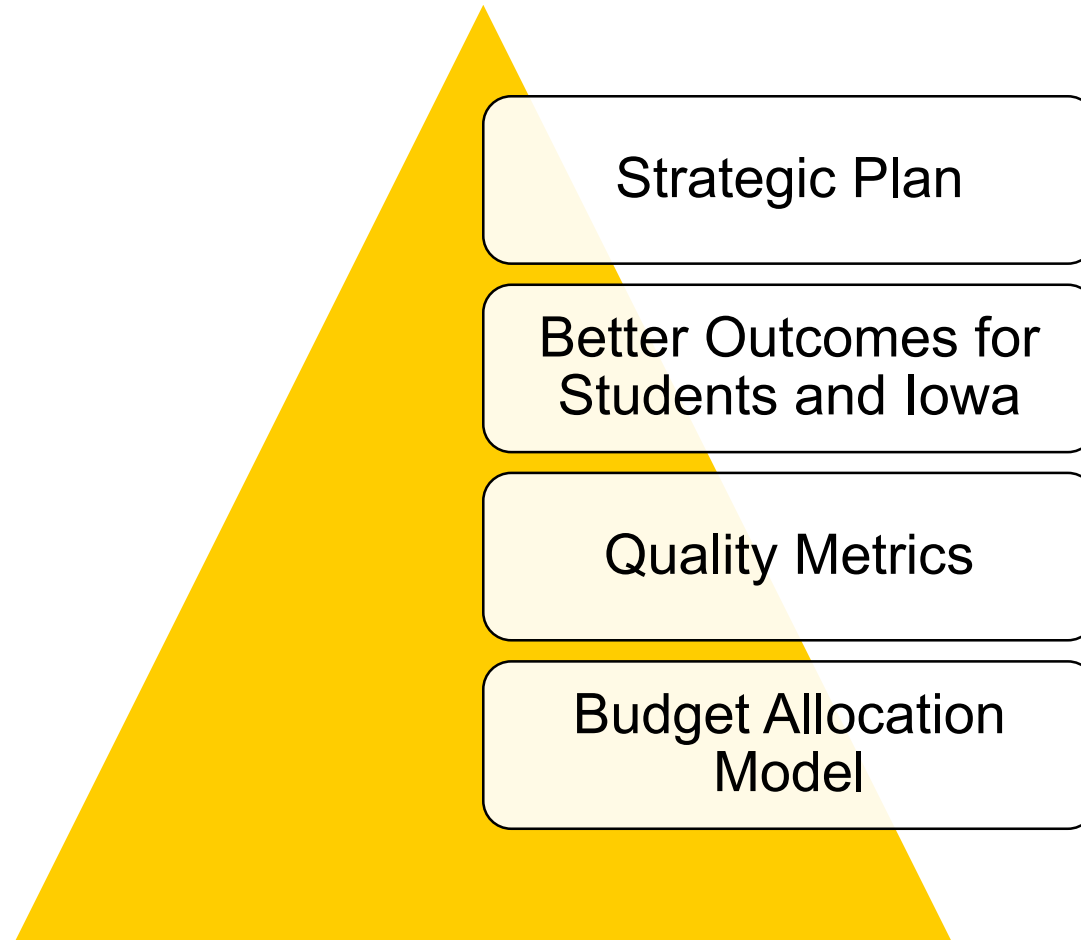

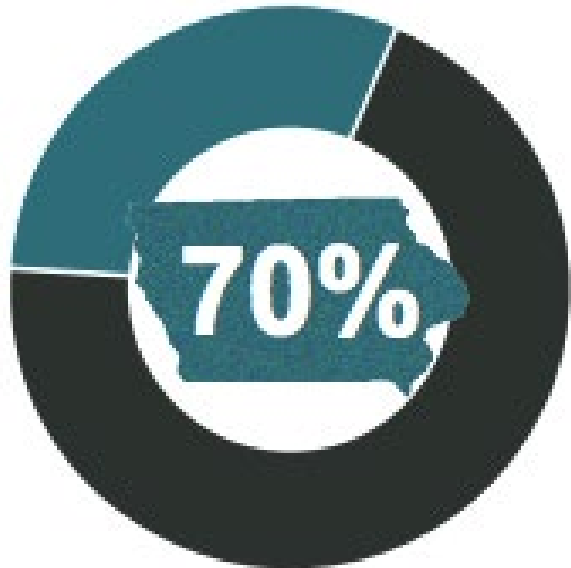

Future Ready Iowa's Postsecondary Educational Attainment Goal by 2025



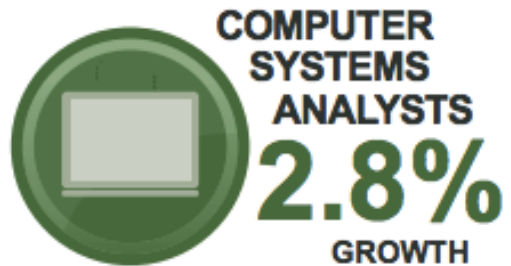
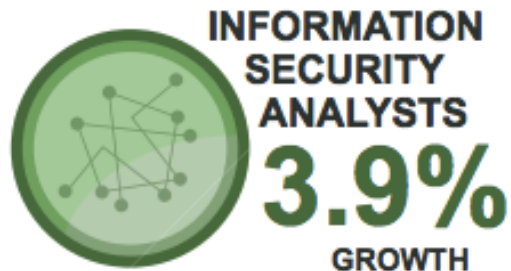

Strategic Plan – Student Success

Improving Quality Outcomes

- ➔ High Impact Practices – (Research, Internships, Service Learning, etc.)
 - 62% of graduating seniors report **two** or more
 - Goal is 60% of graduating seniors reporting **three** or more by 2021
- ➔ 4 year graduation rate
 - 10% increase over past decade 44% ➔ 54%
 - Goal is 60% by 2021
 - Professional advisors now in every department in College of Liberal Arts to increase graduation rate

Student Debt

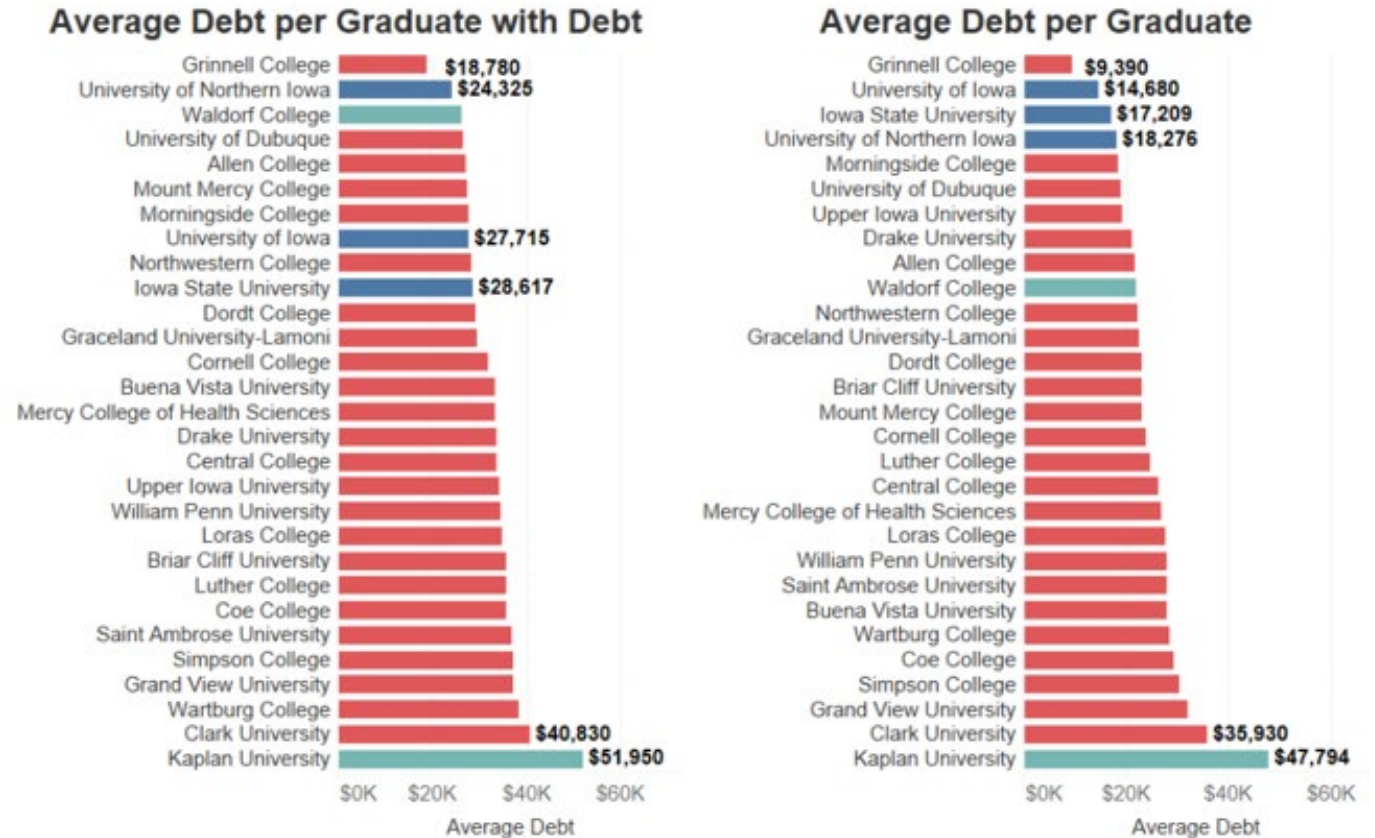
→ Average debt per graduate with debt

Supporting Future Student Success

FY 20 Legislative Request:

\$7 Million for resident undergraduate need based aid

At the UI:

- 45% graduate with \$0 debt
- Over \$1,200 reduction in average debt since 2014
- 10% increase in four-year graduation rate in the past decade



Forward Momentum

UI budget allocation model

- ✓ Shifts the power, responsibility, and incentives from central admin to the colleges and units
- ✓ Local decisions will provide better opportunities for students, faculty, and staff
- ✓ Will spur local innovation and encourage collaboration
- ✓ Implemented for FY 19
