FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

When will the initial assignments take place?

Letters notifying members of the open choice period will begin to be distributed in March 2019.

How many members will transition to lowa Total Care?

lowa Total Care will receive a minimum membership of 25 percent (or about 150,000) of all lowa Health Link members. This number is likely to fluctuate based on member choice.

Do members have to accept their initial assignment?

No. During the open choice period members can change their initial assignment to any of the MCOs. Members have this choice until June 18, 2019, for coverage effective July 1, 2019. However, members can still opt to change their MCO for any reason until September 30, 2019.

How will the initial assignments work?

The new MCO assignments will be chosen by an algorithm. Please note – approximately 140,000 members will not be included in the auto assignment to minimize disruption of their critical health care needs. These members include pregnant women, members with severe illnesses, and members who have transitioned from a long term care facility back to the community.

Will families stay together?

Yes. Families will remain grouped together with the same MCO.

If a member isn't assigned to Iowa Total Care, can they still switch to them?

Yes. During the open choice period, IA Health Link members can choose any of the three MCOs for coverage.

If I switch to Iowa Total Care, will my services stay the same?

Services will not change as long as eligibility remains the same. However, each MCO has additional value-added services that may be unique to their individual health plan.

When will hawk-i members transition?


A similar open choice period will be held for *hawk-i* members starting in July 2019. More information will be provided in the coming weeks.

IA Health Link Members Have a New Choice

You have a new choice for health coverage in the IA Health Link managed care program. Iowa Total Care is now accepting members for coverage starting **July 1, 2019**.

Because of this, all members in the IA Health Link program are now in an Open Choice Period through June 18, 2019. This means you may choose which of the three Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) you wish to enroll with for coverage starting July 1, 2019. Until then, you will remain with your current MCO.

You may have been reassigned to a different MCO than the one you are currently enrolled with. You can choose a different plan. On the back of this letter you will find the MCO assignment for you/your family. IF YOU ARE HAPPY WITH YOUR ASSIGNMENT, YOU DO NOT HAVE TO DO ANYTHING.

During the Open Choice Period the person(s) listed on this letter can change their MCO for any reason. If you don't make a change by June 18, 2019, you will be enrolled with the MCO assigned to you.

These are the MCOs that you can choose from:

- Amerigroup lowa, Inc.
- Iowa Total Care
- UnitedHealthcare Plan of the River Valley, Inc.

If you do not contact Member Services by June 18, 2019, you will be enrolled with the MCO assigned to you on the back of this letter effective July 1, 2019. After that you may change MCOs for any reason until September 30, 2019. Throughout the year, you may change your MCO for reasons of "Good Cause."
