<p>Health Facilities Division</p> <p>Inspects, licenses and/or certifies health care providers and suppliers in the State of Iowa. Nursing facilities, skilled nursing facilities, hospitals and home health agencies are certified for participation in the Medicare and Medicaid Programs.
