Dear Senator Schuerer and Representative Raecker:

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Recently my office received an inquiry about the impact of a 5% reduction in our FY01 budget and the impact of a FY01 deappropriation of the under-budget personnel services reflected on our Schedule 9.

Either of the above actions, by itself, would create great hardship for the treasurer's office. Every dollar appropriated to the office is committed to performing the services described in the handout provided to the subcommittee earlier this month. The bottom line is there is no room for budget cuts without cuts in service.

The treasurer's office prides itself on being fiscally conservative. Although our responsibilities have expanded, the treasurer's office has not asked for an increase in our operating appropriation for nine years. In just the last year, for example, the treasury assumed responsibilities related to the Vision Iowa program and the Tobacco Settlement Authority without additional funding.

Essentially, the result of cuts in funding at this point would require cuts in staffing, since personnel services comprises more than 80% of our operating budget. If staff is cut then obviously programs, services, or functions must be cut as well. I would respectfully ask for the subcommittee's direction in identifying areas for reduction.
