#### All-Agency General Records Retention Schedules

General Schedules: Administration (ADM)	Reference	Description	Disposition Notes/Policy
Policy and operations	ADM 01- 05.G	Records documenting policy discussions, decisions and implementation, including, but not limited to:  Executive correspondence.  Commission/council minutes.  Internal and statewide policies and procedures.  Agency program or subject files relating to planning and programming development.  Systems analysis, surveys, studies and proposals.  Emergency plans.	Retain in office at least 5 years past end of State fiscal year during which records are no longer current. Offer to State Archivist for permanent preservation (see State Archivist criteria.).

#### State Records Manual

#### Records Officer

A Records Officer is a year round, full time agency official who possesses a broad understanding of programs and records of an agency and who is designated by the agency head to coordinate the agency records program or programs for the management of all agency records – regardless of format or final disposition. To more effectively manage the records of the agency, agency heads may choose to appoint more than one records officer.
