Iowa JPEC Overview

The John Pappajohn Entrepreneurial Center is the hub for entrepreneurship education and outreach at the University of Iowa.

Areas of focus include:

- Deliver campus-wide undergraduate and graduate for-credit education
- Accelerate student, faculty/staff, and community-based new venture creation
- Connect university students with state of lowa companies for strategic business consulting, internships, and placement
- Collaborate with external partners to enhance the state of lowa's entrepreneurial ecosystem and support economic development



Iowa JPEC - Academic Programs

Undergraduate Programs:

- Majors in college of business and college of liberal arts and sciences
- Campus-wide certificate in entrepreneurial management
- Specialty certificates in engineering, arts, and journalism

Impact:

- Over 5,000 enrollments in entrepreneurship classes
- 90+ different majors across campus participate in entrepreneurship programming

Iowa JPEC - Student Ventures

- →690+ student businesses supported since 2004 Founders Club program inception
- →\$200K+ in SEED FUNDING provided during FY20
- → 188 aspiring student entrepreneurs from 131 businesses participated in Founders Club in FY20
- →15 teams made up for 24 students participated in the Hawkeye Startup Accelerator Summer 2020
- → Multiple pitch and business model competitions across campus

Iowa JPEC - Student Ventures

OpenLoop is a web-platform designed to help match healthcare providers with hospitals and other facilities including telehealth that require extra staffing assistance

Highlights include:

- Participated in first-ever Techstars
 Iowa cohort in the Fall of 2020
- Completed beta testing with 80 physicians and four partners hospitals in Iowa; raised initial seed round
- Currently servicing 95 hospitals, 5700 clinicians across 50 states, and four telehealth clients

Iowa JPEC - UI Innovators

→ Campus Outreach

- \$300,000 National Science
 Foundation I-Corps grant awarded to train faculty entrepreneurs
- UI Innovators, an NSF I-Corps
 Program, is designed to help UI
 Faculty, Staff and Students develop
 marketable ideas and accelerate the
 startup process.

→ Program Impact

- 285 participants and 137 teams have participated in UI Innovators since 2015 program inception
- 11 teams have advanced to National NSF I-Corps and received an additional \$50,000 in funding

- 2nd place, \$25,000 at the statewide Pappajohn Venture Competition
- Received funding from Wellmark Venture Capital Fund
- Received funding from US Department of Defense
- Global member of MATTER a medical startup incubator in Chicago, IL


- → Delivered online educational webinars on how to weather the financial challenges due to COVID-19
