Re: Notification of Change of Allocation for FY02

Please consider this as notification of a change in funding allocation of \$1,014,304 from the Indigent Defense Fund to the State Public Defender.

As a result of appropriated level of funding and the across-the-board reduction, without this change of allocation the State Public Defender would have to maintain current vacant positions and layoff additional attorneys for the remainder of the FY02 in order b limit spending to the current level. The cost of each case handled by a public defender [\$210] is considerably lower than the cost of each claim submitted by a private, court-appointed attorney [\$444]. The best business plan to achieve the overall targeted reduction is to maximize the number of cases handled by public defenders rather than private, court-appointed counsel. The change of allocation will allow the State Public Defender to become fully staffed and handle an increased number of cases.

This will result in short-term fiscal benefits to the General Fund in FY02 and additional long-term benefits to the General Fund in future fiscal years.
