Cherokee Mental Health Institute Lease Purchase Notification

The Cherokee Mental Health Institute (MHI) of the Department of Human Services has submitted a lease purchase notification for the purchase of a detection system that allows for the tracking of patients and staff throughout the hospital. The system is needed to provide increased security and safety at the new facility housing the Civil Commitment Unit for Sexual Offenders at Cherokee.

The total cost of the system is estimated at \$301,000. This includes \$277,000 in principal and \$24,000 in interest. The estimated interest rate of the agreement is 3.35% for a period of five years. Annual payments will total approximately \$60,000. The annual lease payments will be paid from appropriated funds.

This system will assist us in monitoring patients and protecting our staff by a faster notification and responses to emergencies or escapes. We have never had this capability in the past; our hope is we will have fewer injuries of staff and patients. In the past we have lost staff to injuries, they are unable to return to work and are on long term disability......hopefully this system will help us reduce or even eliminate these sorts of injuries and attacks. Delays, we would maintain status quo, and continue to have patient and staff at risk.
