HOUSE/SENATE COMPARISON INFRASTRUCTURE APPROPRIATIONS BILL

HF 862 AS COMPARED TO SF 600

House File 862 Funding Summary:

Other Funds — FY 2022: This Bill appropriates a net total of \$121.9 million for FY 2022 from the following sources:

- Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund (RIIF): \$90.2 million in FY 2022.
- Technology Reinvestment Fund (TRF): \$31.7 million in FY 2022.

Rebuild lowa Infrastructure Fund — Other Years: This Bill also appropriates \$11.5 million in FY 2023.

General Fund — **FY 2022:** This Bill suspends a \$17.5 million standing appropriation from the General Fund to the TRF for FY 2022 and appropriates \$35.0 million to the TRF from the General Fund. This action funds the TRF for FY 2022 and makes funding available for \$31.7 million in new TRF appropriations enacted in this Bill and \$3.0 million in FY 2022 appropriations that were previously enacted. To avoid double counting, this \$35.0 million appropriation is excluded from the totals above.

Senate File 600 Funding Summary:

Other Funds — FY 2022: This Bill appropriates a net total of \$106.9 million for FY 2022 from the following sources:

- Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund: \$91.2 million in FY 2022.
- Technology Reinvestment Fund: \$31.7 million in FY 2022.
- Autism Support Fund (ASF): \$750,000 in FY 2022.
- Sports Wagering Receipts Fund: \$1.5 million in FY 2022.
- Note: The net total of \$106.9 million in the Bill reflects an adjustment of \$17.5 million to avoid double counting
 appropriations from the RIIF to the TRF, and from the ASF to the RIIF in FY 2022. The total also excludes a \$17.5 million
 standing appropriation from the General Fund to the TRF. These totals do not include previously enacted appropriations.

Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund — Other Years: This Bill also appropriates \$7.4 million in FY 2023.

Difference Between HF 862 and SF 600: The difference between the House and Senate appropriation is \$15.0 million in FY 2022 and \$4.2 million in FY 2023.
