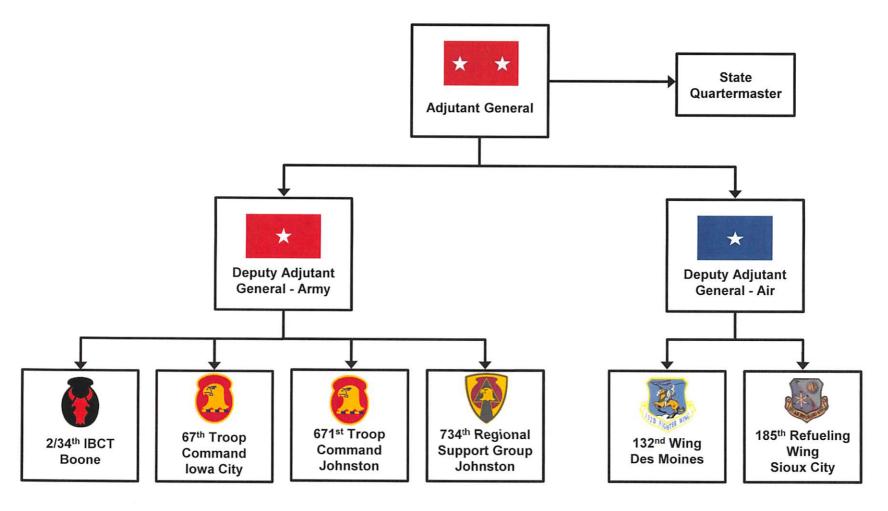

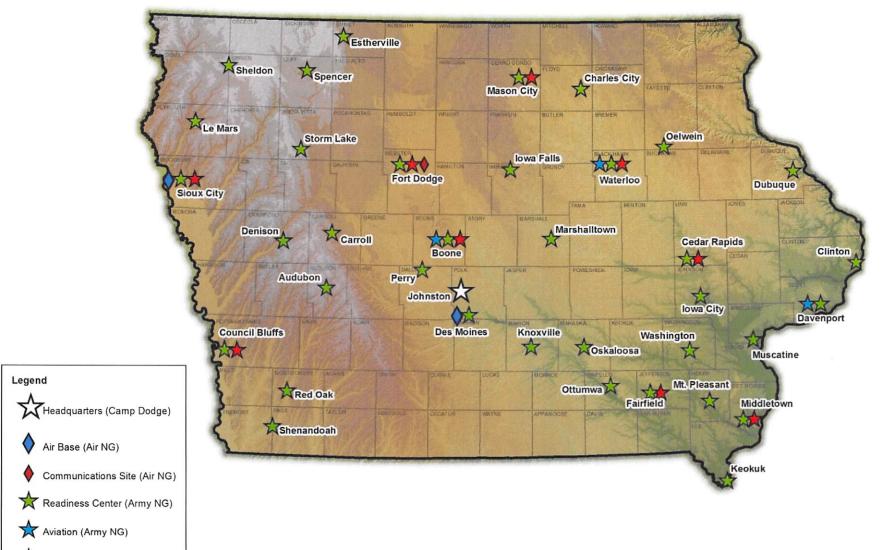

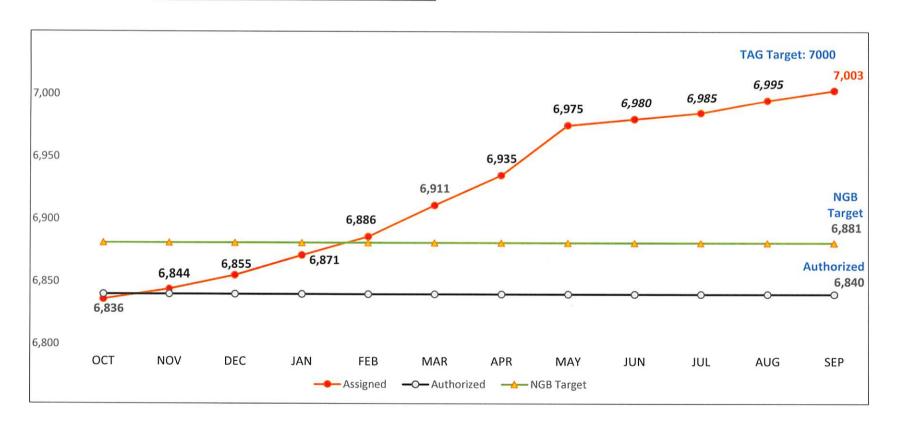

Iowa Army National Guard Strength 2010-2021

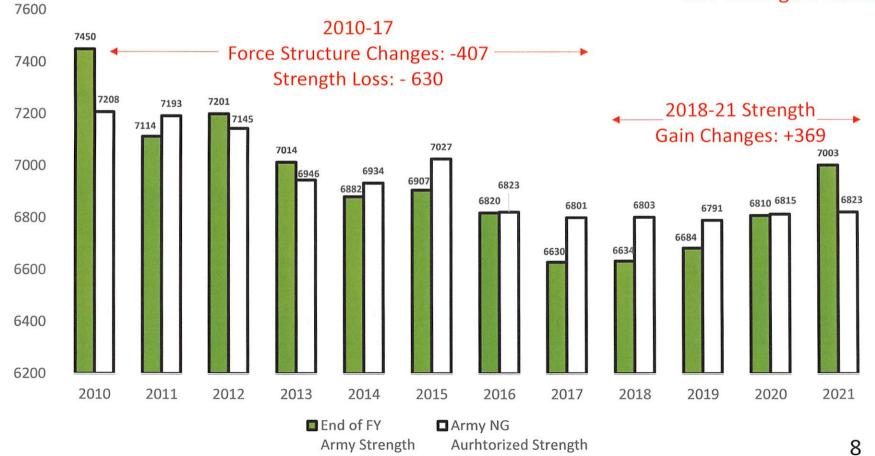

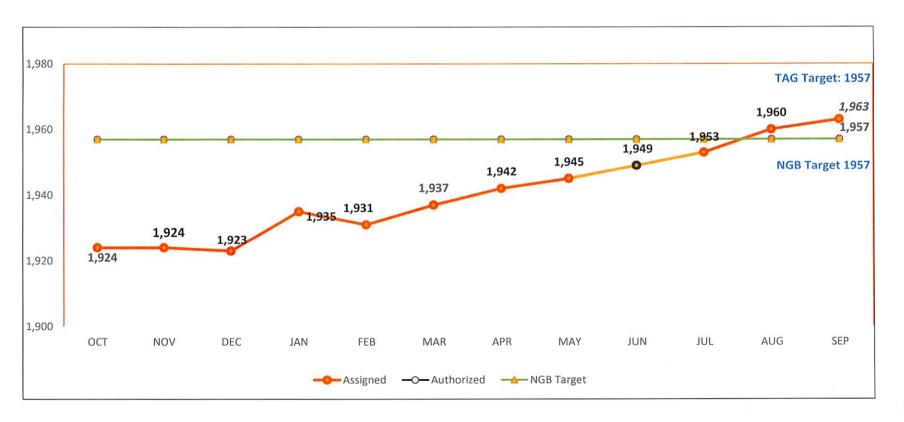

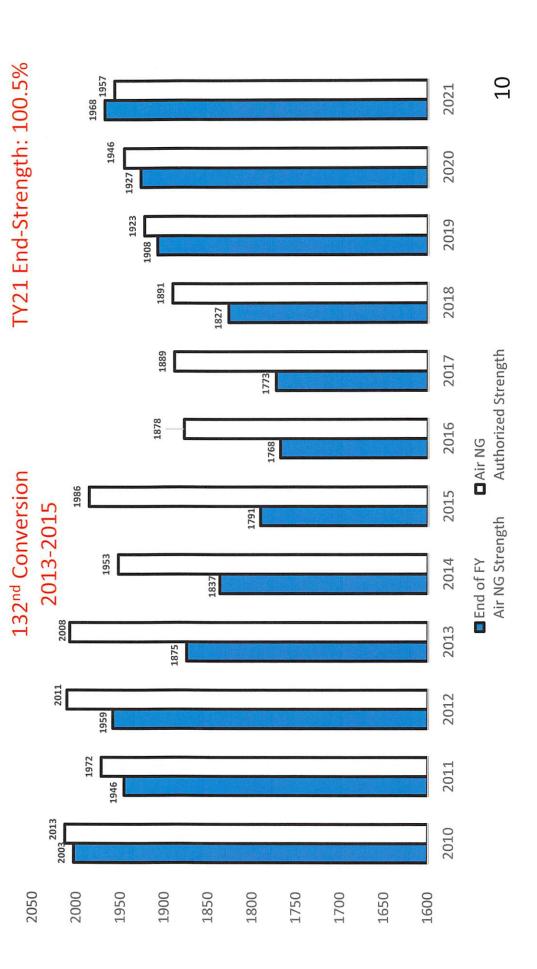




Iowa Air National Guard Strength 2010-2021

1. General Fund: \$6,916,601

2. RIIF 30D (Maintenance): \$1,000,000

3. RIIF 54D (Improvement Projects): \$1,000,000

4. RIIF 59D (Camp Dodge Infrastructure): \$250,000

Additional Requests Above Status Quo

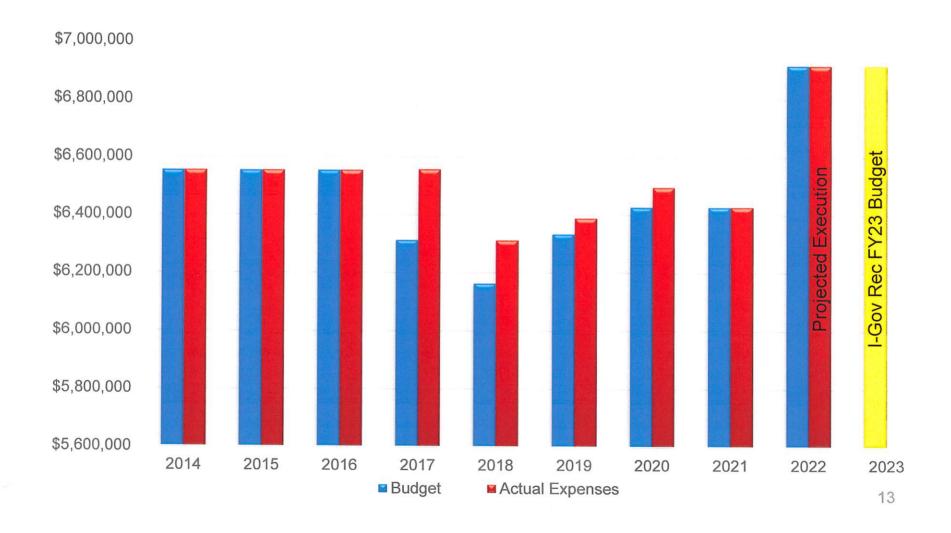
- 1. **TRF** (Technology in support of COOP) TRF funding would be utilized to address the following needs related to operational sustainability, redundancy and recoverability of the following business objectives for all state agencies in order of priority: \$500,000

 - SADApp (State Active Duty Application
 - State Fiscal Office business processes in support of IANG
 - File and print services
 - Collateral web services
- 2. RIIF 30D (Maintenance): \$1,100,000
- 3. RIIF 54D (Improvement Projects): \$1,100,000
- 4. RIIF 59D (Camp Dodge Infrastructure): \$300,000

IDPD General Fund Budget Summary 2014-2022

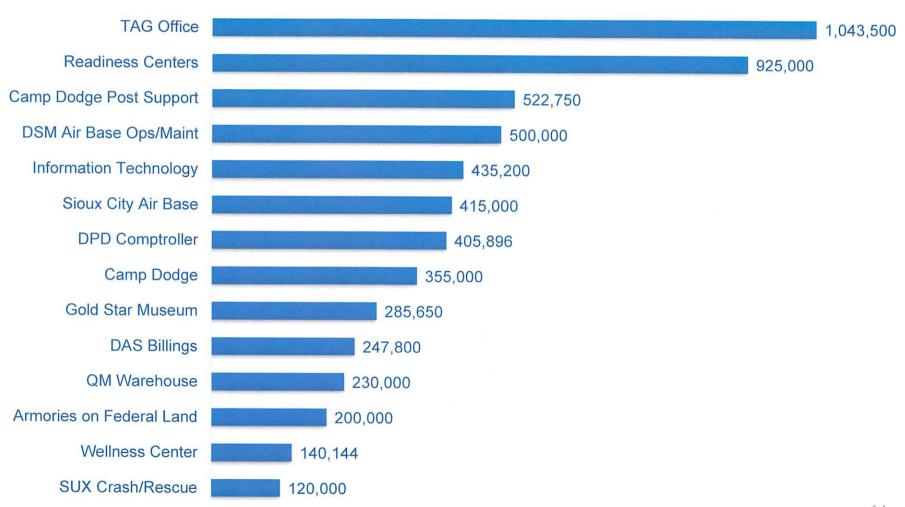




General Fund Appropriations
