



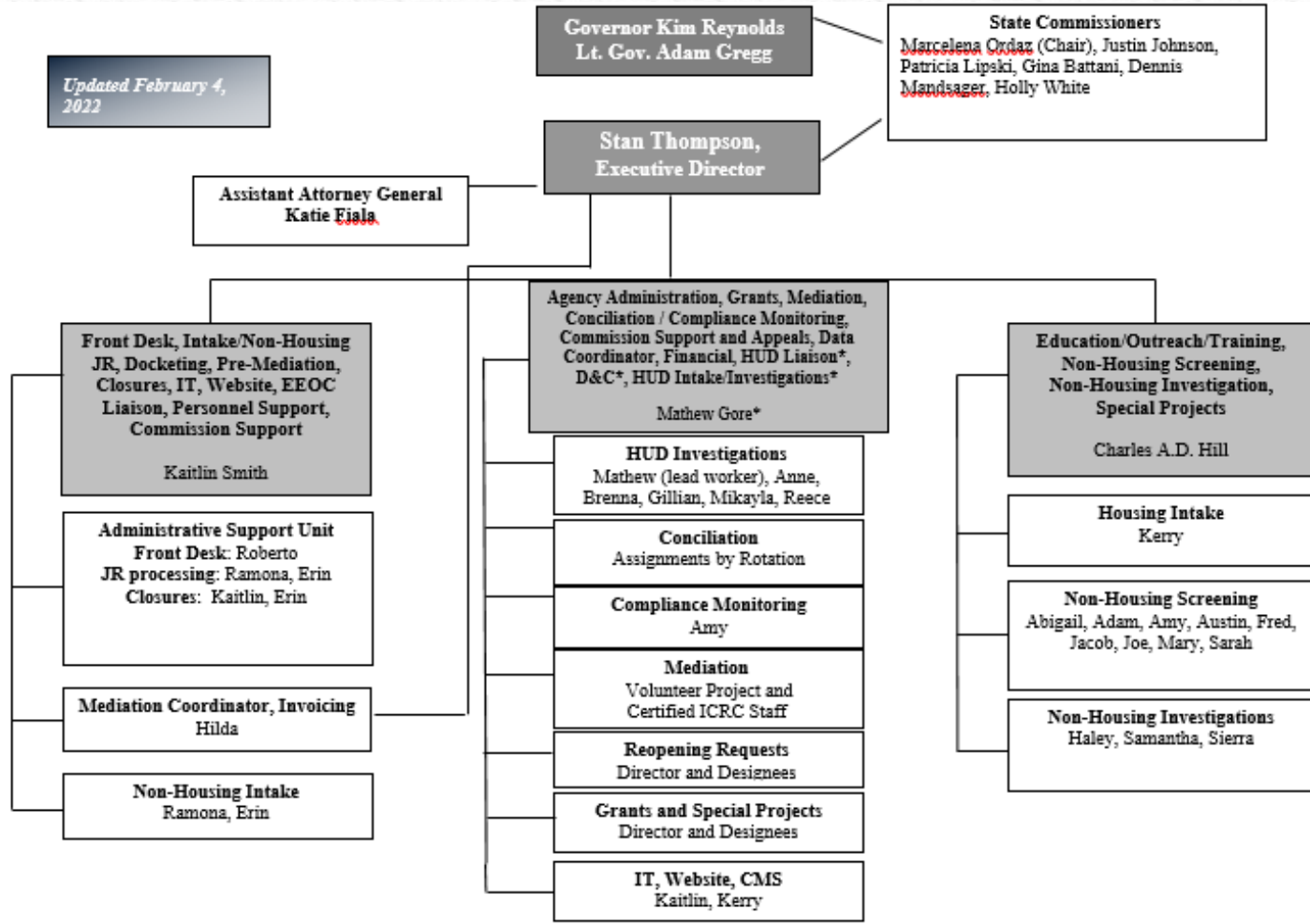

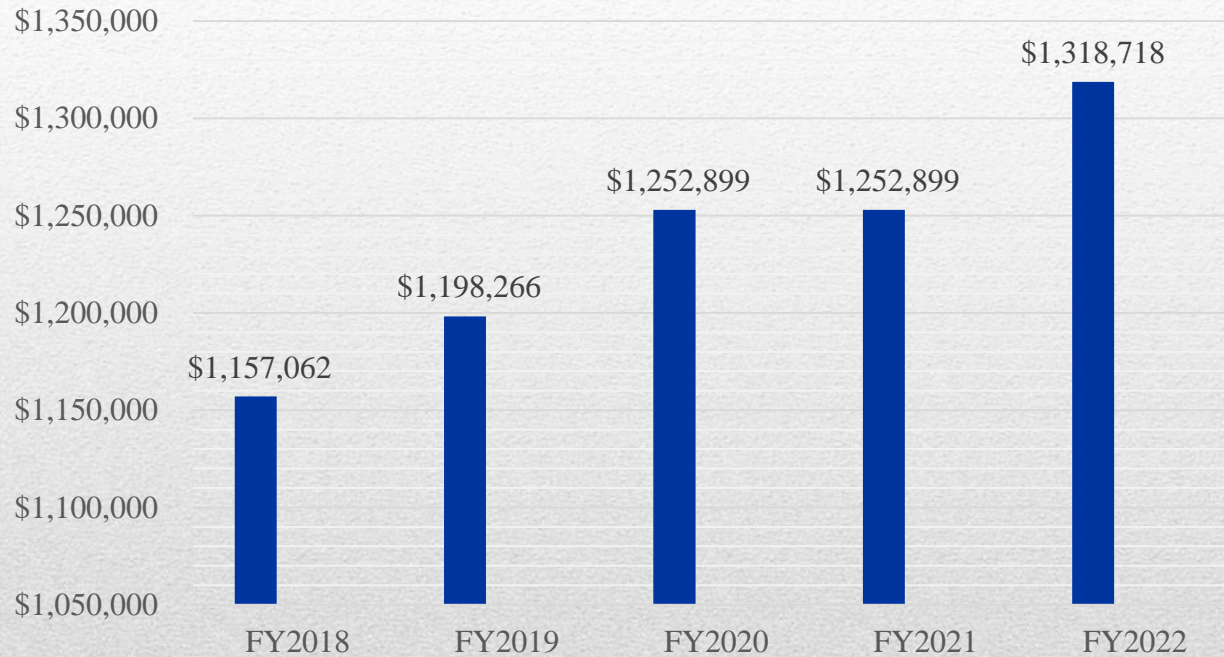

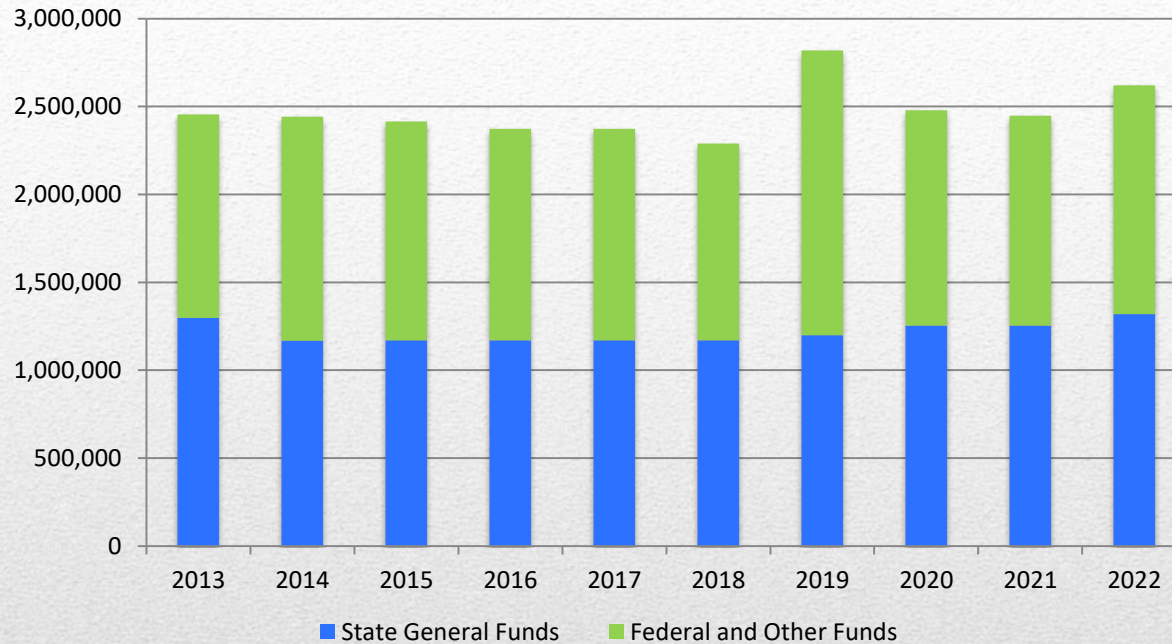

FY 2023 Budget Request: \$1,318,718

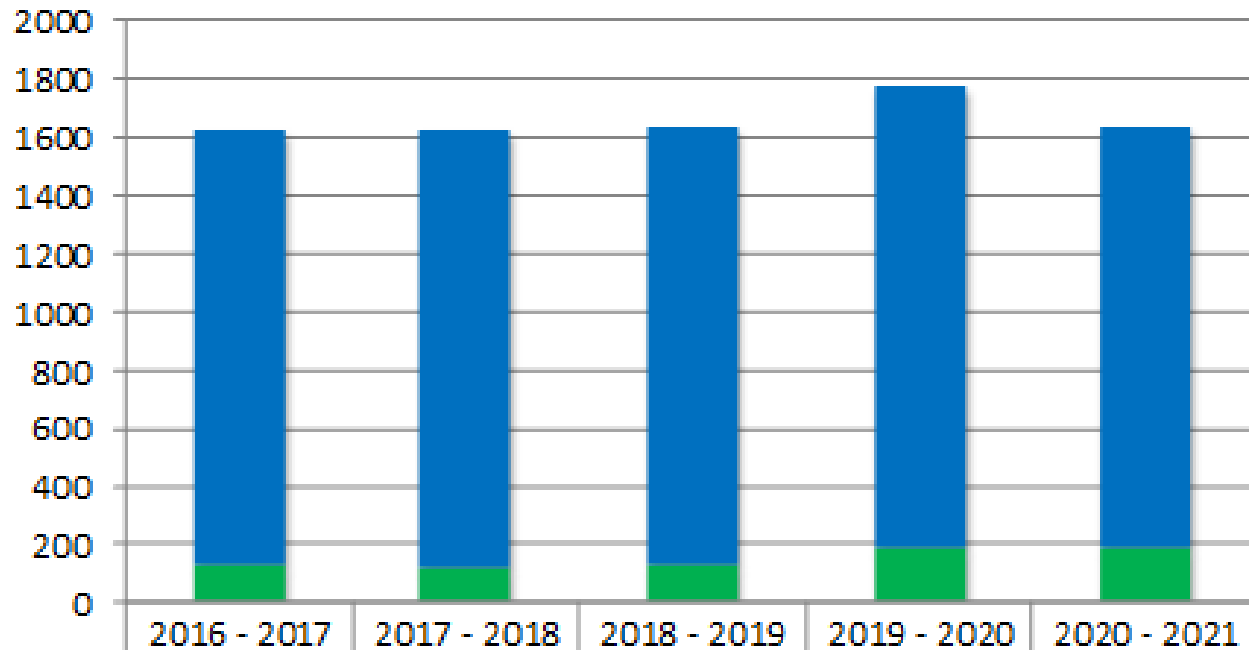

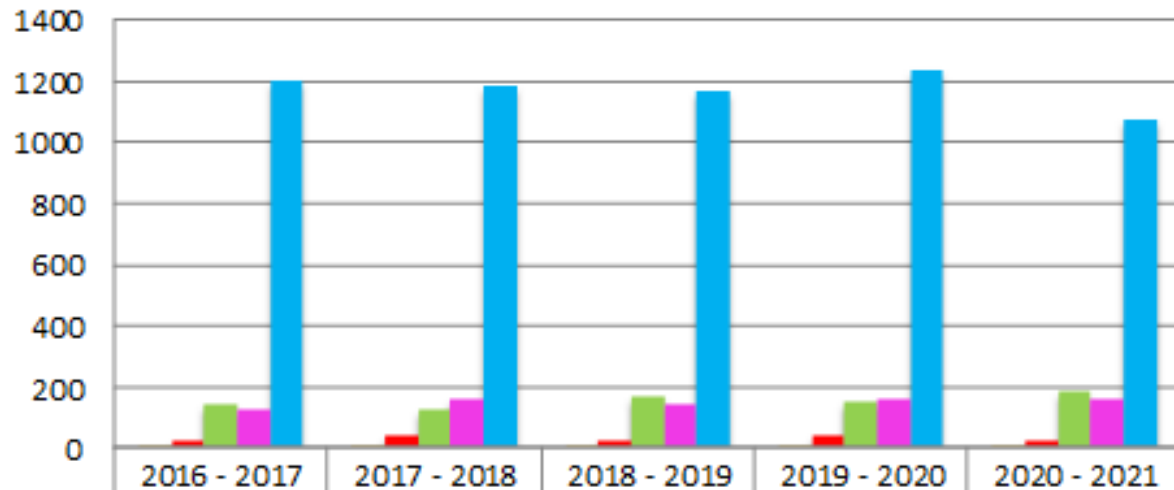

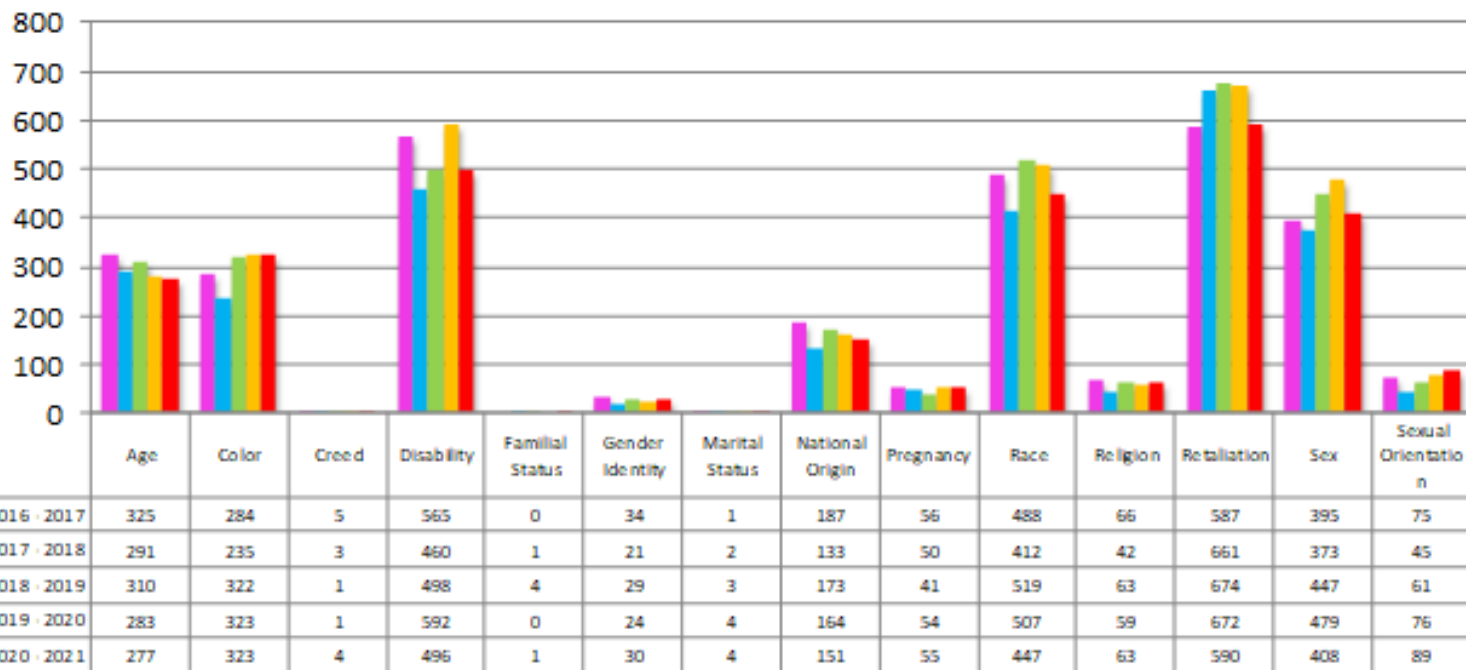

Complaints Filed in Past Five Years

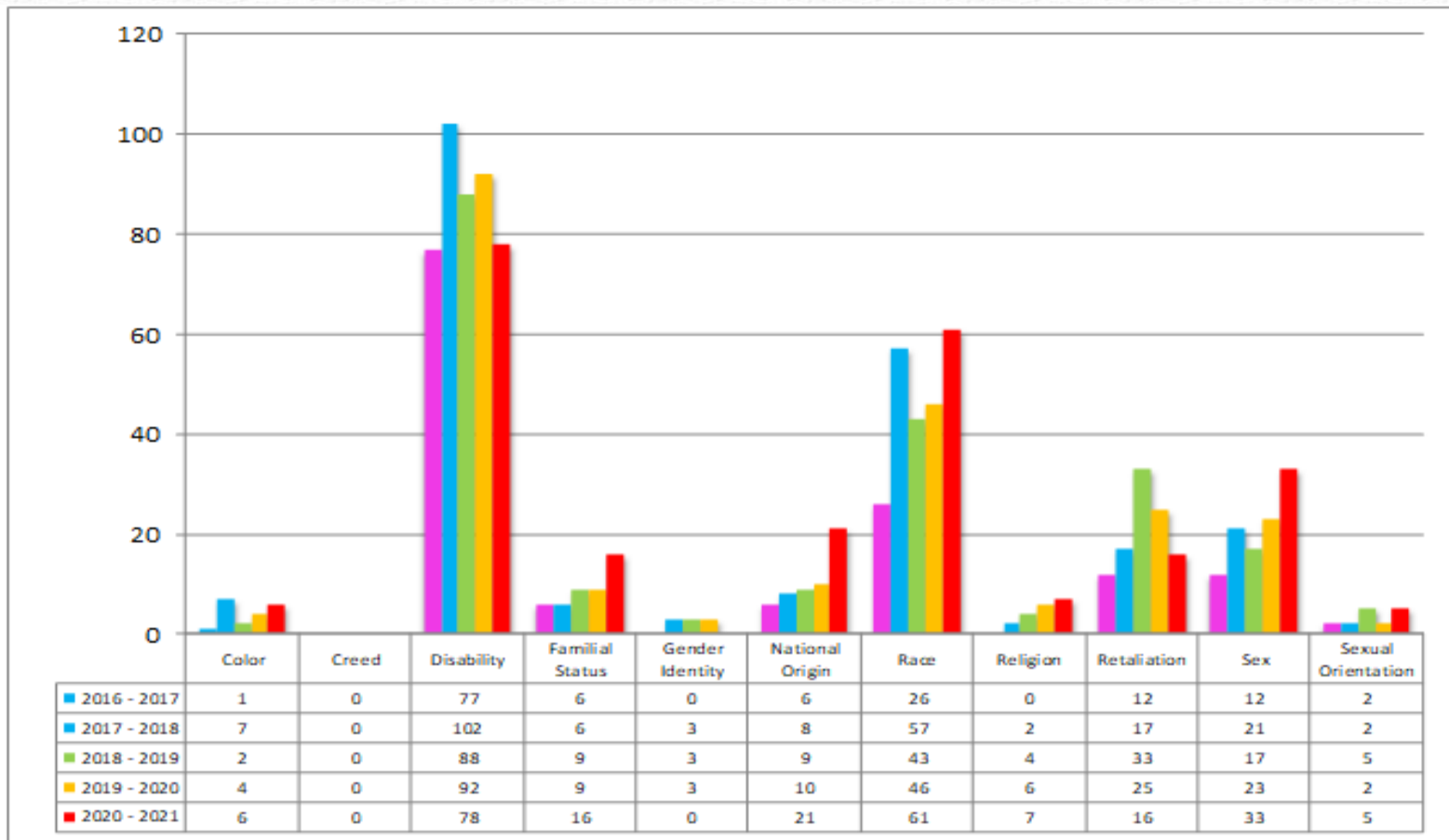

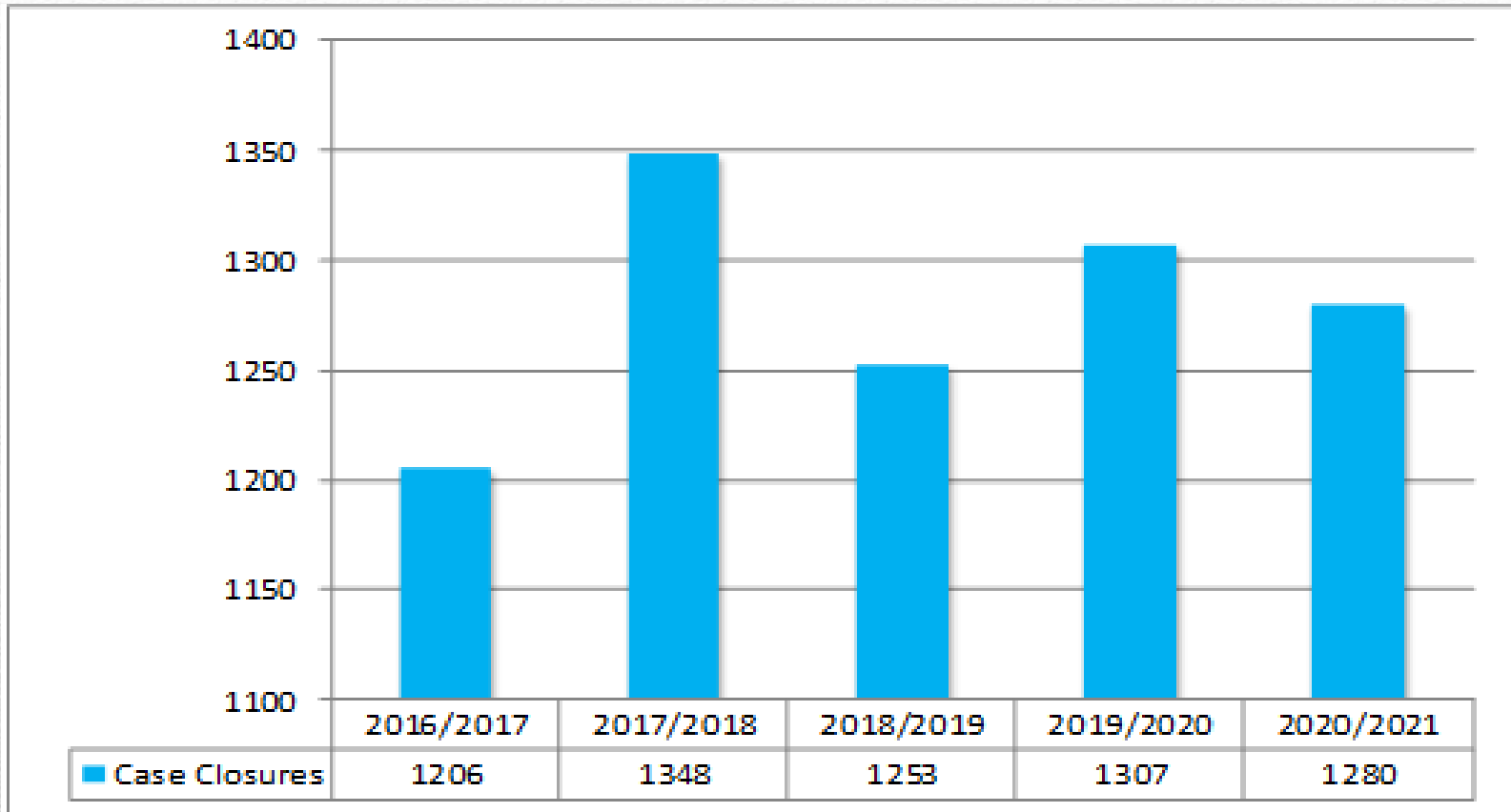
Complaints Filed by Area



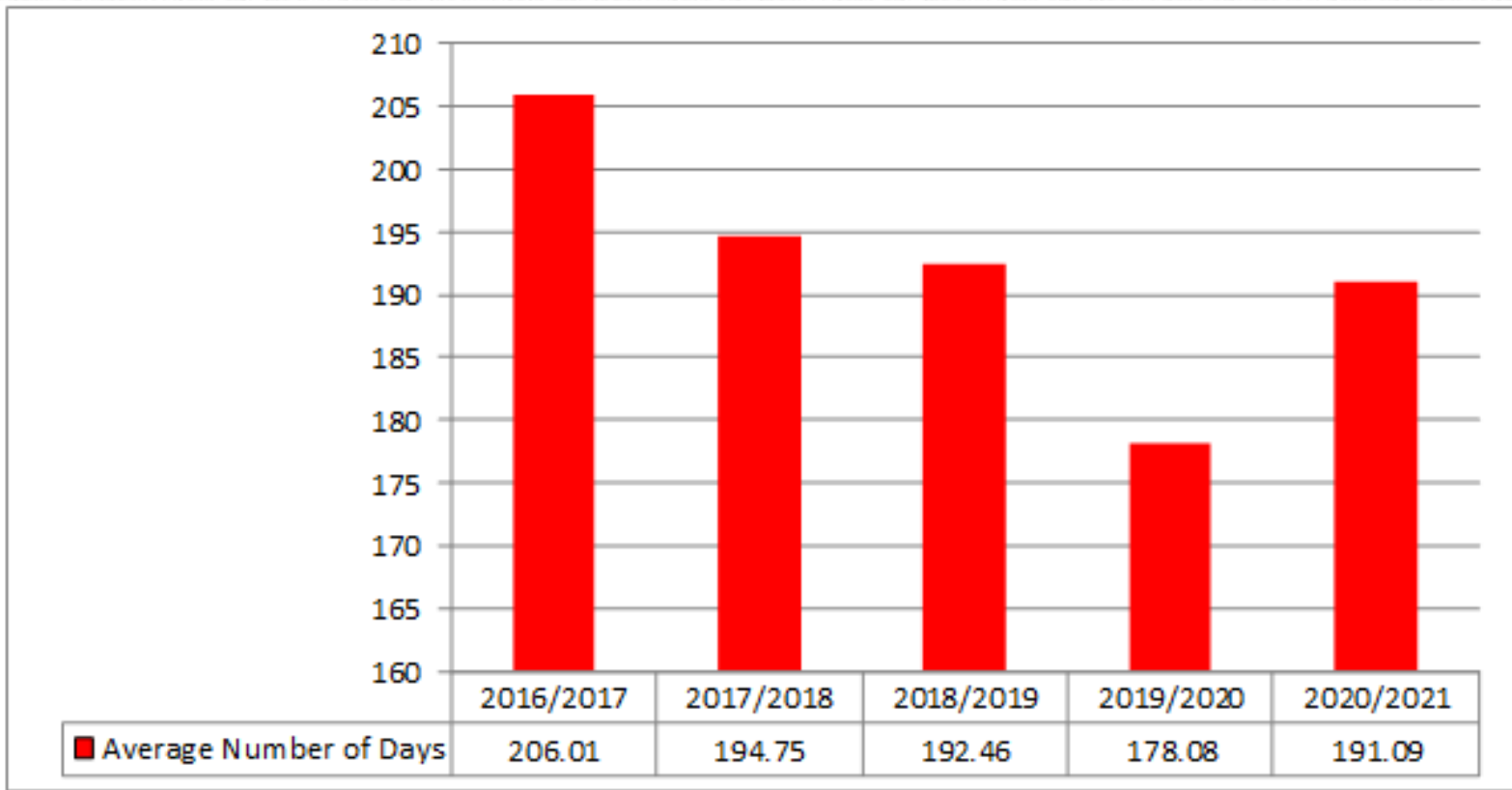
Complaints Filed by Basis – Non Housing

Number of Cases Closed



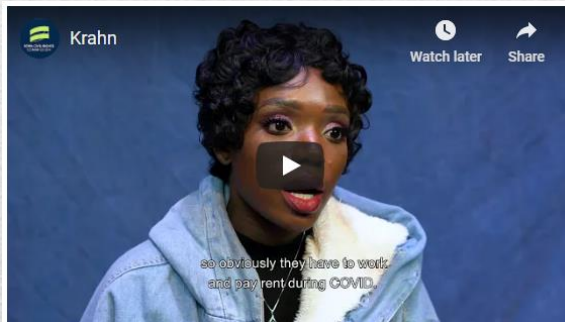
Average Number of Days to Process a Complaint
