



# Cherokee Mental Health Institute (CMHI)

- Location: Cherokee, lowa
- Services: Short-term, acute psychiatric care for mental illness
- Population served: Children, adolescents, and adults with severe symptoms of mental illness
- Staff (as of 12/27/22): 162
- Capacity: 36 (24 adult & 12 child/adolescent beds)
- Current Census (as of 12/27/22): 29 (24 adults & 5 children/adolescents)
- Average Daily Census (FY22): 35 (24 adult & 11 children/adolescents)
- Annual Admissions (FY22): 133 adults & 197 children/adolescents
- Average Length of Stay (FY22): 55 days for adults & 19 days for children/adolescents

# Civil Commitment Unit for Sexual Offenders (CCUSO)

- Location: Cherokee, Iowa
- **Population Served:** Individuals who have been committed by the court for treatment purposes. The department cannot deny a court-ordered admission. Annual court reviews of progress are required to determine if the commitment will continue.
- Services: Secure, long-term highly structured inpatient treatment
- **Staff (as of 12/27/22):** 134.5
- Capacity: 144 (122 secure & 22 transition)
- Census (as of 12/27/22): 134 secure & 14 transition

### Independence Mental Health Institute (IMHI)

- Location: Independence, lowa
- Services: Short-term, acute psychiatric care for mental illness
- Population served: Children, adolescents, and adults with severe symptoms of mental illness
- Staff (as of 12/27/22): 173
- Capacity: 56 (40 adult & 16 child/adolescent beds)
- Current Census (as of 12/27/22): 49 (35 adults & 14 children/adolescents)
- Average Daily Census (FY22): 51 (39 adult & 12 children/adolescents)
- Annual Admissions (FY22): 34 adults & 65 children/adolescents
- Average Length of Stay (FY22): 277 days for adults & 69 days for children/adolescents

# State Training School (STS)

- Location: Eldora, Iowa
- Population served: Delinquent male youth between the ages of 12-18
- Services: Treatment and educational services
- Staff (as of 12/27/22): 169
- Capacity: 80 beds (64 during construction)
- Census (as of 12/27/22): 54

### Glenwood Resource Center (GRC)

- Location: Glenwood, Iowa
- Services: A full range of active treatment and habilitation services
- Population Served: Individuals who have intellectual or other development disabilities that require treatment and support at the level of care provided by an Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/ID)
- **Staff (as of 12/27/22):** 648.5
- Capacity: 188
- Current Census (as of 12/27/22): 113 on site; 20 in waiver

### Woodward Resource Center (WRC)

- Location: Woodward, lowa
- Services: A full range of active treatment and habilitation services
- Population served: Individuals who have intellectual or other development disabilities that require treatment and support at the level of care provided by an Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/ID)
- Staff (as of 12/27/22): 549.9
- Capacity: 221
- Current Census (12/27/22): 122 on site; 42 in waiver
