



Tapping venture capital funding, connections and expertise








Culture

Piecing together a foundation to transform ideas to impact:

- Infrastructure: 8.2M from State to create a medical innovation hub supporting growth in commercialization
- Seed Funding: 200k per year for CCOM, additional 350k funding for Engineering, Nursing, Dentistry, Education, Pharmacy
- Match Making: Bringing external advisors, engaging industry experts "just in time" support of faculty/staff innovations,
- Alternative entrepreneurial pilots: State-wide Nursing Innovation,, Biodesign program pilot, IILF program
- Communication Strategies: building connective synergies across campus and w/external stakeholders
- Benchmarking best practices: codifying what attracts entrepreneurial faculty by studying best practices at peer institutions

 - Extend the UI medtech innovation support model across the State











Iowa Innovation Leadership Fellows


- Launched in Fall 2023 to include 12 Fellows in postgraduate training
- Fellows interact with experienced entrepreneurs, venture capitalists, UI faculty innovators, and UI leadership
- Goal: Build connections with and enhance training of graduate students around the commercialization process



Medical Innovation Hub

- Renovate existing space with \$8.2 million investment from the State, from ARP funding to provide a location for medical innovators to
 - Gather and interact
 - Continue technical development of their ideas
 - Form initial companies
 - Interact with outside companies, venture capital
- Fills Key Gap in the Innovation Infrastructure
 - No available space to perform these functions close to their "day jobs"
- Will house equipment, meeting spaces, and device testing resources


