SUPPORTING LOCAL PRODUCERS

- Specialty Crop Promotion and Capacity Building Grants
- 30 Grants will be awarded by September 2024

Grant recipients receive:

- Up to \$1,500 of funding to support capacity building
- Up to \$1,000 of funding to support outreach and promotion efforts
- Technical assistance to implement a fruit and vegetable incentive program


