#### **DOM Overview**

- Provide a framework and environment for integrating budgeting with planning to improve decision-making
- DOM 21 full-time staff
- OCIO 98 full-time staff
- OCIO aligned under the Department of Management in July 2022





## State Budget

- Prepare Governor's executive branch proposal
- Chair and facilitate the Revenue Estimating Conference
- Assist departments with budget preparations
- Evaluate the fiscal and policy impacts programs and budget proposals
- Manage the I/3 budget system
- Monitor & report on CARES act, CSLFRF, and ARPA funds





## **Local Government**

- Establish forms and computer software for all 3,531 local governments to provide budget estimates and certify property tax levies.
- Certify final property tax levies for all taxing jurisdictions to county auditors
- Collect and aggregate statewide property valuations
- Compute and distribute utility replacement tax data
- Process city and county annual reports
- Determine the amount and distribution of school aid
- Provide searchable local tax rate information via the DATAshare website
- Monitor & report on CARES Act, CSLFRF, and ARPA funds





### Performance Results

- Administer the major provisions of the Accountable Government Act
- Provide a framework, tools and technical assistance for actively using performance data to improve state government results
- Facilitate the sharing and communication of data related to government finances, operations and programs, and their performance.
- Work with executive branch agencies to train Lean facilitators, and to identify, implement and track Lean initiatives.
- Facilitate high impact, cross enterprise events



## State Appeal Board

- Process approvals, rejections and payments of claims, tort and general, against the State or a state employee
- Resolve local budget protests



## Grants Management

- Implement lowaGrants.gov, the electronic grant management system
- Provide the software to post grant notices, applications, selections, awards, monitoring, reporting, finances, site visits, status reports, communications and more
- Maintain a database of grant applications





#### Oversight responsibilities for agencies including:

- IT Procurement
- Enterprise IT and Information
- Security Standards
- Agency Technology Planning
- Application Development

#### Iowa Code 8B allows DOM-OCIO to serve

- Executive, Judicial, and Legislative branches
- Iowa Counties and Cities
- Iowa Educational Institutions
- lowa not-for-profits





### Cybersecurity Achievements

- Established the State of Iowa Cyber Incident Response Team (CIRT).
- Implemented Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) for all workforce members.
- Deployed additional protections to protect local governments (counties and cities).
- Launched the 24/7/365 Security Operations Center (SOC) on April 4, 2022.
- Launched Iowa's Endpoint Detection and Response Service (EDR).

#### **Cybersecurity Support Needed:**

Requesting \$4.1 million appropriation to ensure long term cybersecurity coverage.





## Broadband - Empower Rural Iowa Grants

Since 2018, the Office has coordinated the Empower Rural lowa Grant program to accelerate broadband expansion in unserved and underserved locations across the State of Iowa.


- 7 grant opportunities awarded
- \$352,850,022 in grant funds awarded
- 270 applications awarded
- \$791,203,995 in total new broadband investment (private + public funds)
- 109,126 homes, schools, and businesses served in 99 counties
- New federal funding opportunities available and being explored
  - ARPA Capital Projects Fund (2023) \$152 million
  - IIJA/BIL Broadband, Equity, Access, and Deployment \$300 \$400 million (est)
  - IIJA/BIL Digital Equity Act \$10 \$20 million (est)






## Broadband - Award Locations


#### Iowa Broadband Grant Awards **Project Areas**
