 - 13% increase in new undergraduates
 - 5-year plan to grow to at least 32,000 students
- Campus Visit Numbers in 2022
 - 14,017 students & 20,487 guests
 - From All 99 Iowa counties
 - From 45 states and Washington DC
- Applications for Fall '23 Admission
 - 23,017
 - Up slightly from the record level in 2022

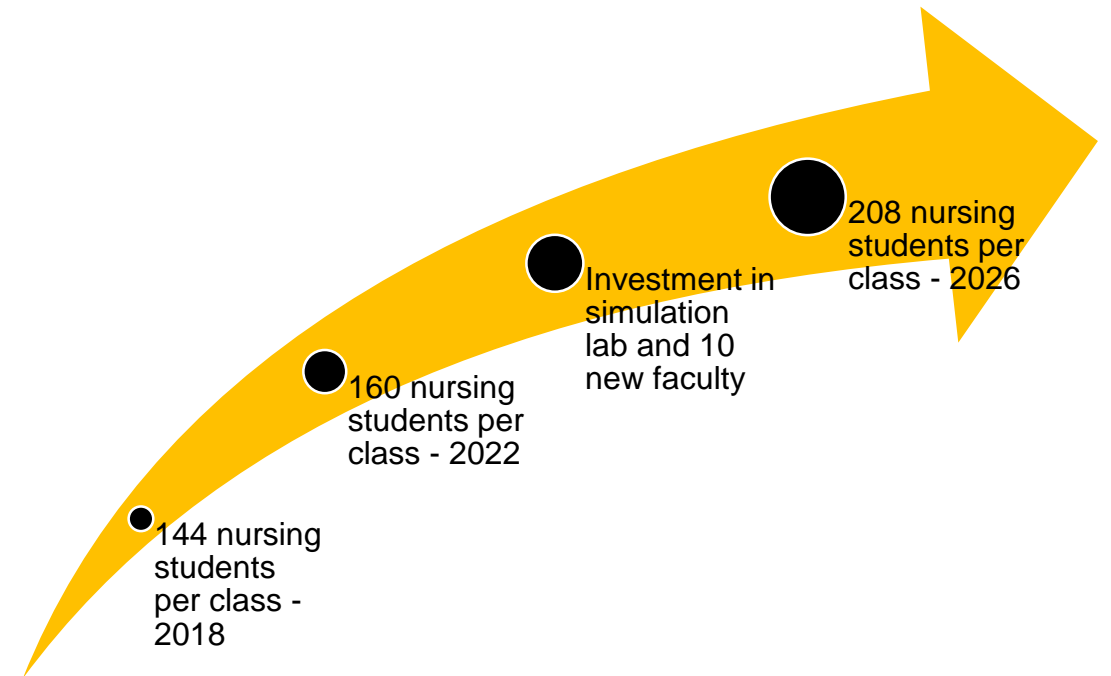
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State Request - FY 24

Funding priorities and investing in the future of Iowa

- **Increasing nursing workforce in Iowa**

- \$6M to renovate and increase simulation training space
- \$1M to hire 10 new faculty
- Iowa will add 48 nursing students/yr
 - 208 students per class by 2026
 - 30% increase over 4 years



State Request - FY 24

Simulation training investment

Improving and expanding training

- Need to update 15-year-old simulation space
 - 11-room clinical simulation lab
 - Perioperative scenarios, pediatric intensive care unit (ICU), neonatal ICU, general pediatrics, adult surgical, adult critical care, and pediatric/adult ambulatory care
- Enhance technology
- Increase capacity

Faculty investment

- **Hiring more nursing faculty to train students**
- **Recent examples**
 - Laura Mae Noel Kendall, MSN, RN
 - Specializes in **oncology, gerontology, palliative care**, and burnout in nursing
 - Bridges relevant, real-time, experience into teaching
 - Clarissa Shaw, PhD, RN
 - Specializes in **dementia care**
 - Has federal grant on communication interventions with nursing home patients

Funding priorities and investing in the future of Iowa

- **First-Generation Hawks Program**

- 1 in 5 of our UI undergrads are first generation to go to college
- **Pilot program** provides peer mentoring, academic coaching, on-campus employment
 - First-year: 61 students
 - Second year: 67 students
 - Third year: 155 students (**73% from Iowa**)

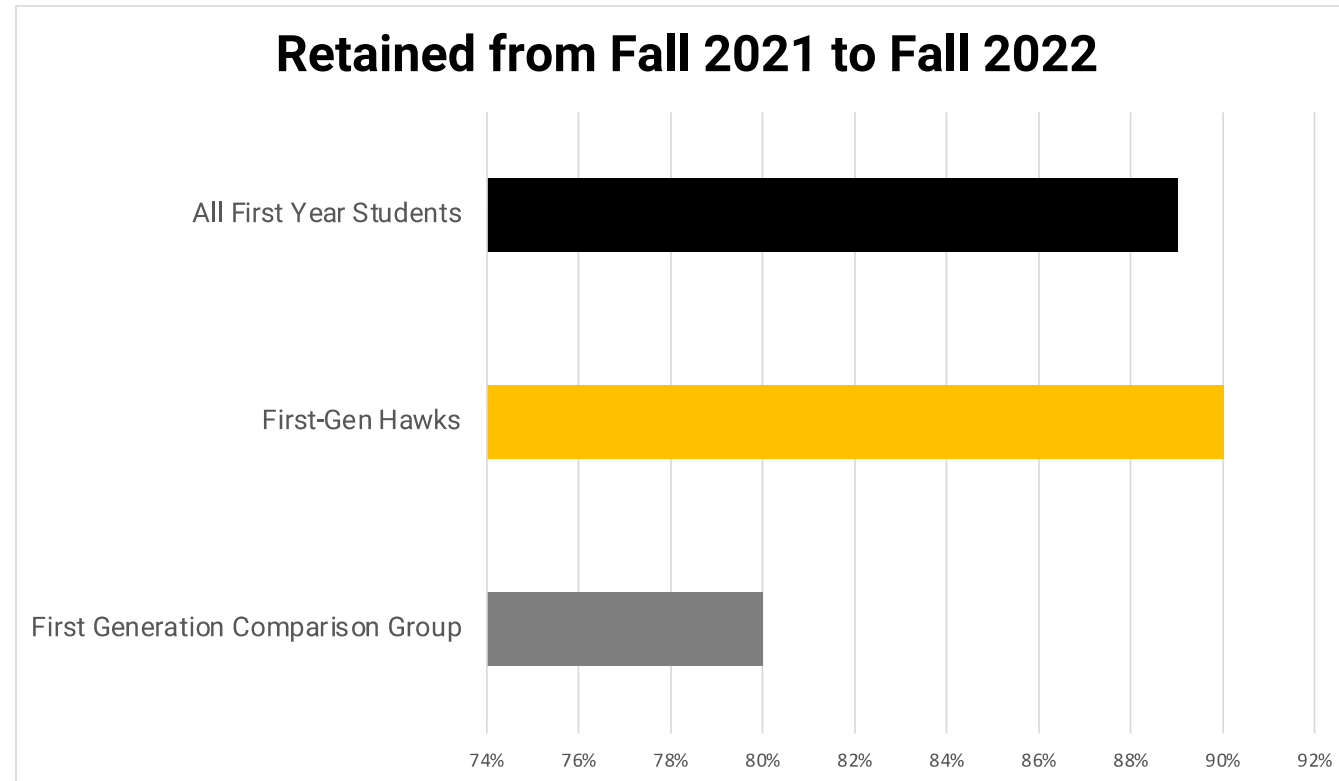


Over the past **three** years participants were from **57** counties.

Investing in Future Success

Retaining and graduating students

- **Investing in First-Gen-Hawks**
 - Program clearly **increases student success**
 - \$1M to **expand to 250 students** and extend for 4 years
 - \$4M to provide **need-based scholarships**
 - Build relationship with **iJAG to support high school** transition to UI
