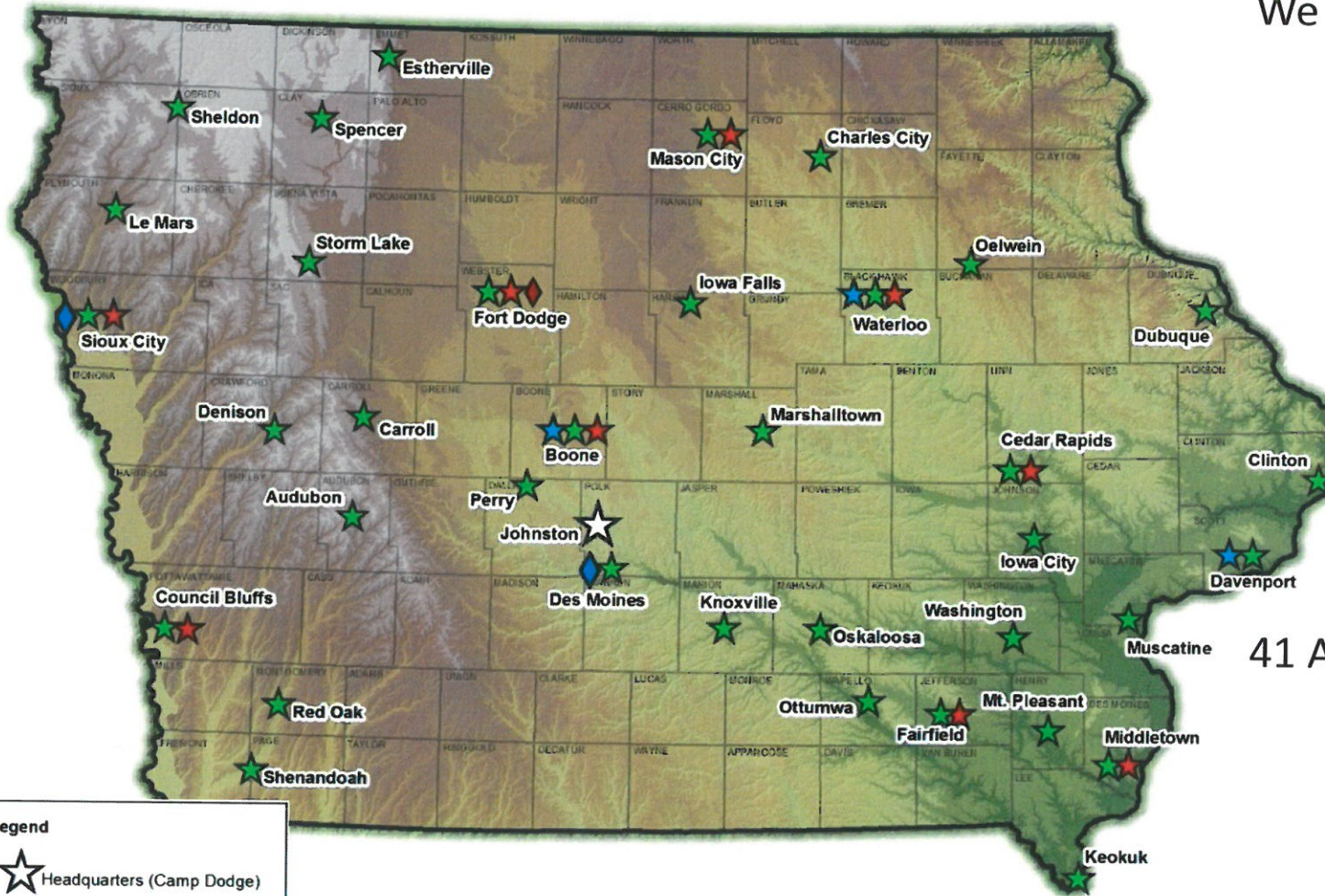

• Building issues start to occur 15-20 years after construction or renovations.
 • Focus for RIIF Funds



- Executed 240 major and minor facilities projects last year totaling \$24.5 million. RIF was a component in 181 of those projects.
- RIF Funding was especially important last year!
 - Inflation put many projects just out of reach of federal project cost limits last summer and fall.
 - RIF funding (often very little of the total project costs) allowed us to continued to bring federal dollars in to repair our facilities.
 - \$3.88 million in RIF was spent.
- RIF Supports Camp Dodge
 - Camp Dodge is the only military training facility in Iowa.
 - Camp Dodge is a hub of training and emergency response for multiple state agencies.

- Camp Dodge Infrastructure - \$250,000
- Capital Improvements - \$1,000,000
- Facilities Maintenance – \$ 1,000,000
- Critical HVAC Repairs - lower level of JFHQ-IA - \$2,440,000

- West Des Moines Armory
 - Change language to of current RIIF monies committed to *“project completion”* rather than current timelines.
 - \$1,800,000 - Expires 30June2024. (HF862)
 - \$3,700,000 - Expires 30June2025. (HF2579)

- West Des Moines Armory bids 2 March, 2023
 - Can request to receive up to an additional \$3 million in federal money due to inflation factors. Not automatically approved.
 - Would require a 25% state match.
