



## Funding



Only about \$7.8 million of the \$31.8 million Main AG Office budget is a General Fund appropriation

## **Funding Challenges**

- The \$7.8 million General Fund appropriation funds only a small portion of the AG Office including existing prosecutors and litigators.
- The other primary funding sources—agency reimbursements or consumer protection funds—can't be repurposed to pay for prosecutors or protecting against federal overreach.

# Keeping Iowans Safe & Protecting Victims

 Iowa needs more prosecutors in the Attorney General's Statewide Prosecutions Section to assist county attorneys with major crimes.



**COULD FACE UP TO 125 YEARS IN PRISON** 





Former Clarksville, Iowa, police officer Michael Tobin Jr. was convicted of three counts of sexual exploitation of a minor, all felonies, and eight counts of possession of a depiction of a minor in a sex act first offense, all aggravated misdemeanors. (Butler County Sheriff's Office)

#### Statewide Prosecutions Section

Over the last 25 years, major crimes in the state have nearly doubled.

	1997	Now
Homicides in Iowa	40	76 (90% Increase)
Rapes in Iowa	663	1360 (105% Increase)
AG Prosecutors for Violent Crimes	11	10 (+3 in FY2024)

We need 3 additional prosecutors to bring the total to 13


## Hiring More Prosecutors

\$884,090 and 6 FTEs would fund:

- 3 attorneys
- 2 investigators
- 1 paralegals

This would properly staff the Statewide Prosecutions Section

## **Cold Case Unit**



585 Unsolved Cold Cases

#### Cold Case Unit

\$523,464 and 4 FTEs would fund:

- 3 investigators
- 1 prosecutor

There is at least one Cold Case in every county in the state.

Local law enforcement is excited to partner with the Attorney General on this initiative.

#### Farm & Freedom Division

\$286,596 and 2 FTEs would fund:

- 1 attorneys
- 1 paralegals

Protect Iowa's interests against federal overreach

Major actions: Massachusetts Question 3, year-round E15, California's electric truck mandate, and protecting the southern border.

## Farm & Freedom Division



Attorney General Bird led the charge on WOTUS, blocking the EPA's rule that would have affected 97% of land in the state.

## Fund State Salary Increase

\$545,466 to fund the 3% increase provided to state employees who are funded by general appropriations.

## Fund Flexibility

Same language from last year's budget bill, SF 562 (formerly HF 727), sections 23-25.

## Support for victims of violent crime

\$4,589,421 is the anticipated cut in VOCA dollars to the victim services division.

This amounts to a 40% decrease in total funding for the office.

## Support for victims of violent crime

Reimburse crime victims

Fund and assist local crime victim service programs

 Provide trainings to law enforcement, prosecutors, and social workers

## Tobacco Settlement Replacement

Settlement brought \$137 million as a one time payment for bonding, and \$39 million into RIIF.

\$1,164,377 to replace the vacated dollars after entering into the tobacco settlement agreement.

## Improving Technology

 Maintaining the \$202,060 line-item for Cybersecurity and IT Infrastructure.

 Adding \$278,503 from TRF as recommended by the Governor.
