

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# Installations



## We Support:

- ~6800 Soldiers
- 1200 Full-time employees
- 511 Buildings
- Over 4.4M square feet under roof (100 acres)

## 43 Readiness Centers:

- 4 at Camp Dodge ~2400 Soldiers
- 10 in 5 metro areas ~2300 Soldiers
- 29 in the rest of state ~2100 Soldiers

- RIIF funding (often very little of the total project costs) allowed us to continue to bring in federal dollars to repair our facilities Up to \$3 Federal for \$1 State
- Executed 340 major and minor facilities projects last year totaling \$24.2 million. RIIF was a component in 180 of those projects
- RIIF Supports Camp Dodge
  - The only military training facility in Iowa and attracts many out of state users
  - A hub of training and emergency response for multiple state agencies
- Significant SY24 RIIF Projects
  - Parking Lot Replacements in Carroll, Council Bluffs, Camp Dodge, Clinton, Knoxville
  - Cedar Rapids Motor Vehicle Storage Building Construction
  - Camp Dodge Water Treatment Plant Modernization

## Additional Impacts

- West Des Moines Readiness Center
  - Substantial completion granted in January 2025
  - Ribbon cutting ceremony scheduled on May 7th
- Camp Dodge Bldg A01 HVAC Projects
  - All contracts are awarded
  - Expected completion this Spring

## State Fiscal Year 2026 Request

- Camp Dodge Infrastructure – \$550,000
- Capital Improvements – \$2,100,000
- Facilities Maintenance – \$2,100,000

## Planned Projects

- Sioux City Vehicle Maintenance Facility
  - \$13.8M (100% Federal) replacement facility
  - Expected contract award in summer 2025
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  - Expected contract award in 2026
- Waterloo Readiness Center Addition and Modernization
  - \$21.6M (\$5.4M State / \$16.2M Federal)
  - Will request \$540K in RIIF funds in 2026 (SY27) for required federal design funds match
  - Will request \$5.4M in RIIF funds in 2028 (SY29) for construction project match
