

Atanasoff's Legacy

John Vincent Atanasoff, a physics professor, invented the first digital electronic computer with his graduate student, Clifford Berry. Atanasoff-Berry Computer (ABC)

Atanasoff Hall was named in his honor and is home to the Department of Computer Science.

Renewing the facility will support his legacy and reflect the level of innovation infused into Iowa State University.





Five Year Capital Plan

- Complete renewal and renovation to 1969 building:
\$33 million
 - **\$8 million from State support**
 - **\$25 million from donors and university**
- Requesting state funds to address deferred maintenance:
 - **\$3 million – 2027**
 - **\$5 million – 2028**
