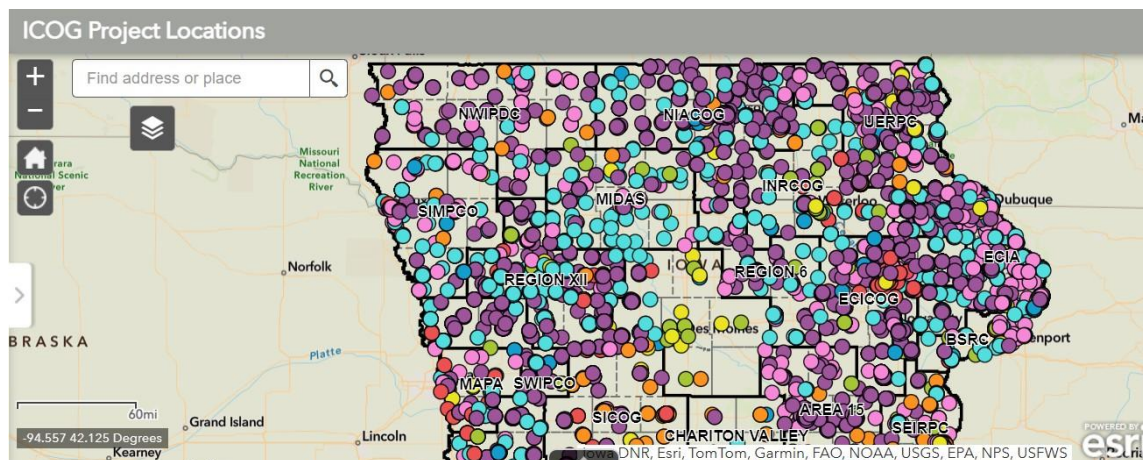

Collaborations That Make a Difference

ICOG collaborates with agencies and organizations statewide, including:

- **Iowa Department of Health & Human Services** on the **5-2-1-0 Healthy Choices Count!** initiative, promoting healthy habits through community projects like playground improvements, water stations, and nutrition education.

Supporting Iowa Communities Through Codification and Model Code Updates

Codification—the process of organizing adopted laws into a comprehensive code of ordinances—is required for Iowa cities at least once every five years. To make this process more efficient and consistent, the Iowa Association of Councils of Governments (ICOG) partners with the law firm Dorsey & Whitney, LLP to develop and maintain a model code available to member COGs.

This collaboration ensures that communities using the model code can more easily align their city ordinances with changes in Iowa statutes and common law.

To keep codes current and compliant, ICOG and Dorsey conduct an annual review with COG staff. These reviews help identify areas that may need updates and ensure communities remain proactive in maintaining clear, effective ordinances.

Education & Training

ICOG provides ongoing education for COG staff and the public, including:

- Annual updates and training on the **Model Code of Ordinances** in partnership with Dorsey
