Request: Please provide the number of offenders currently housed within the CCU that have been there since it opened.

Response: The 200-bed Clinical Care Unit (CCU) at the Iowa State Penitentiary became fully operational in June 2003. Below is a chart showing the inmate count of the CCU at the end of each fiscal year as well as today. **As of today, there is one offender there who has been continuously incarcerated at the CCU since the unit was opened.**
