- Sec. X. Section 321I.1, subsection 17, paragraph "a", Code 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- a. "Off-road utility vehicle" means a motorized vehicle with not less than four and not more than eight non-highway tires or rubberized tracks that is limited in engine displacement to less than one thousand five hundred cubic centimeters and in total dry weight to not more than two thousand pounds and that has a seat that is of bucket or bench design, not intended to be straddled by the operator, and a steering wheel or control levers for control. For the purpose of this Chapter, the definition of off-road utility vehicle includes type 1, type 2, and type 3 off-road utility vehicles.
- Sec. X. Section 321I.1, Code 2013, is amended by adding the new subsection as follows: "Off-road utility vehicle type 1" means an off-road utility vehicle that is limited in total dry weight to one thousand two hundred pounds or less and is 50" or less in width.
- Sec. X. Section 321I.1, Code 2013, is amended by adding the new subsection as follows: "Off-road utility vehicle type 2" means an off-road utility vehicle that is limited in total dry weight to two thousand pounds or less and is 65" or less in width.
- Sec. X. Section 321I.1, Code 2013, is amended by adding the new subsection as follows: "Off-road utility vehicle type 3" means an off-road utility vehicle that exceeds 2,000 pounds and/or 65" in width.
