Potential rates for SPOC Single and Family plans assumes a 35% increase in total premium. Blue Cross and Blue Shield opened negotiations with a proposed 45% increase in premiums. The Department of Personnel indicates that the negotiated increase will be significantly more than the 22% increase which occurred on state plans January 1, 2001.

The Department of Public Safety has managed the unfunded portion of this increase (\$43 1,000) by holding positions vacant for a longer period of time and delaying purchases of supplies and equipment for the balance of the year.
