



EMD Wide Area Network Status



BASIC GOAL

To provide the citizens of Iowa with a statewide multi-hazard warning system

What's next?

As the project has grown in magnitude and complexity, additional staff have been assigned to assist in the search for donated tower space. Emergency Management Division continually works in partnership with various agencies and entitles in a search for "best fit" tower locations for the remaining unidentified transmitter sites.

It is our hope the project will be completed during 2001. However, In working within the constraints of the project and asking for donated space, this date may not be achievable.

The Process

- a Obtain tower search information from NWS Central RegionHeadquarters, if not previously provided
- a Review tower **search** information to determine height of tower, and closest location to overall expansion project "wish list"
- a Contact tower owner. explain overall project to owner, emphasizing public service and donated space
- Provideanyneededinformationregardingequipment and specifications

The Process

- a If owner agreeable, obtain information needed for signal **profile.** (latitude/longitude at site, and height at which antenna can be placed
 - · Optimum antennaplacement height is 200' and above
 - > Do NOT want to have antenna extending above top of tower
- Send information obtained for signal profile to NWS requesting a signal profile; If signal pmfile shows positive coverage area, schedule to wervisit for completion of site survey form; survey information provided to NWS
- a Request NWS Central Region head quarters schedule tech visit to site for their approval

The Process

- Oncetech visitis completed, if site is approved, request NWS Central Region headquarters prepare Cooperator Agreement for IAAssoc. Electric Cooperative signature
- NWS to begin lease negotiations with tower owner
- Once lease is signed, statecontacts and coordinate rigging of tower with rigger and tower owner
- When tower rigging is complete, EMD proceeds with installation of transmitter at site
- **Transmitter** is operational
- Contact NWS local office, local officials and tower owner to schedule media/dedication day, if owner desires


The Process

- 30 day testing period
- State facilitates the gifting of the transmitter to the National Weather Service
- If ail steps in the previously displayed process go smoothly, the site could possibly be approved and ready for tower rigging and transmitter installation within 2-6 months.
