## **Staff Development and Training**

### Introductory comments:

- Corrections statewide training delivery is structured to include centralized, regionalized, local, and technology based delivery options.
- Many courses are offered locally by Academy and institution or district staff, and via ICN to reduce travel and overtime expenses.
- Training audiences includes both institution and community corrections personnel and are a mix of security, program and support staff.
- Some corrections topics listed below (see \*) share some basic concepts with what might be taught to law enforcement personnel.
- Corrections personnel are not sworn law enforcement personnel and certification standards therefore differ.
- The corrections training program is transitioning to a competency- based format.
- Training delivery is limited by available training facilities, training staff, and costs related to overtime and replacement costs for staff attending classes.
