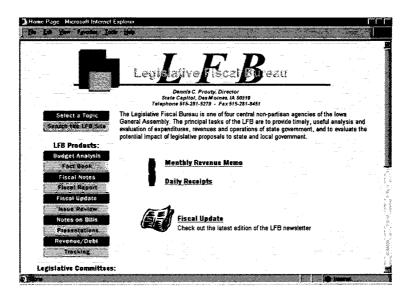
Legislative Fiscal Bureau Web Site Information for the Joint Education Appropriations Subcommittee January 5, 2001
