# Iowa Land Records A Brief History



#### ILR – A Brief History

- » Origin of CLRIS 2003
  - How ILR Was Created
- » 2005 Launch and Controversy
  - Polk County, Audits
  - Fund 255, 823 and Treasury Management
  - ♦ Governance 28E
- » 2006 E-Submission System Completed
- » 2007 Transition From Development to Maintenance
  - Sustainability Budget
  - Future Improvements
- » Sale of Bulk Data
  - Current Practices
  - Alternative Delivery To Heavy users



#### The Purpose of the County Land Record Information System is to ...

- Create a Statewide Land Record Indexing and Imaging Database
- Make Land Record Information Accessible through the Internet
- Enable Electronic Submission of Documents for Recording



#### Status – Through September 2, 2008

- The Iowa Land Records Portal has been completed
- All Counties Connected and Uploading Data
- 36,000+ Registered Users
- 10,000,000+ Document Records
- Centralized Hosting, Customer Service and Accounting
- Now Version 2.14



# Iowa Experience

- Early E-Submissions (2007)
  - » Few Banks and Law Firms
- Now (2008)
  - » Third Party Submitters
  - » 2500 Electronic Recordings Per Month
  - » Nearly 32,000 Electronic Records Since 2007
  - » \$1,000,000.00 in Recording Fees and Transfer Taxes Paid Electronically
  - » All Counties (Except Hamilton, Pottawattamie and Black Hawk)




# Iowa Land Records Privacy Issues A Brief Review



#### The Recorder's Index

- Public Notice of Real Estate Transactions
  - » Protect Property Rights and Prevent Fraud
- Key Index Information
  - » Document Reference Numbers
  - » Date of Recording (Order Matters)
  - » Names of Persons and Organizations in Real Estate Transactions
  - » Legal Description
  - » Document Type
  - » Associated Document References
- Other Information
  - » Document Images











# The Recorder's Index

- Information NOT Indexed
  - » Street Address
  - » Social Security Numbers
  - » Account Numbers
  - » Birth Dates
- Document Images
  - » May Include Other Information If Not Redacted
  - » Recorders Do Not Edit Original Documents
  - » Recorders "Record" The Documents Presented
  - » Public Records Under Section 22.2 (Iowa Code)



#### Foundation of Initial ILR Privacy Policies

- Public Records Custodians
- Role of Preserving and Providing Access
- Practice of Local Access and Bulk Sales
- Legislation Directing Free Access
- Capacity For Individual Redaction

#### Changes In ILR Privacy Policies and Circumstances

- Ombudsman Concerns Re: Tax Liens
- 2002 SSN Legislation
- ◆2005 ILR Became a Public 28E (ILR records became public)
- 2006 Redaction RFI
- Actions to Upload Pre-2004 Indexes and Images
- 2007 Personal Information Legislation



#### Data Tree Agreement

- First American/Data Tree Had Access To the Records
  - » Public Records Access Similar To Local Practices
- Data Tree High Usage of ILR Search Tools
- Discussion of Alternative "Bulk" Delivery
- Draft Agreement Prepared
- Action Deferred Pending Legislative Review
- Fees Would Be Primarily Distributed To Counties
- Model For Other State or Local Organizations

» Intent To Make Available On Same Basis

 If Recorders Shouldn't Provide Electronic Access to Data Tree, Then We Probably Shouldn't sell CDs or Data Files To Other Companies Either



# Recent Privacy Concerns

- Focus On Social Security Numbers
  - » Concerns About Other Information
    - Account Numbers
    - Real Estate Records are "Public Records"
  - » Iowa Code Sections 331.607 and 22.2
- The "Preparer" Determines the Content of the Records
- Since 2002 Social Security Numbers
   Prohibited Expanded in 2007 To Include
   Account Numbers
  - » Liens Exempt From Prohibition



# Recent Privacy Concerns

- No Known Cases of Fraud or Identity Theft
- Precautions Included:
  - » Images of State and Federal Tax Liens Restricted
  - » User Registration
  - » No Private Information Included In Index Data
  - » Individual County Redaction Policies
  - » ILR Redaction Upon Request Consistent With 2007 Law
  - » All Real Estate Documents are Public Records Accessible in Any Courthouse – under the law people have a right to examine, copy, publish or otherwise disseminate those records



# Post Labor Day Events

- Notified of Social Security Number Concerns 9.2.08
- Identified Documents and Followed Redaction
   Policy
- Responded to Media Inquiries
- Communicated with Governor's Office
- Temporarily Restricted Access To Mortgages and UCC documents (in addition to liens)
- Became Aware of Redacted Document
   Circumvention
- Disconnected Image Repository 9.9.08



# Iowa Land Records Current Status & Options



#### Iowa Land Records Current Status

- The ILR E-Submission Service is Fully Operational
- Due To Recent Privacy Concerns Image Repository Is Disconnected Until Further Notice
- Land Record Index Search Is Working
  - » Updates Since September 9 Were Disrupted but are now operating
- For Now Records Examination Occurs at the Courthouse
  - » Personal Information Still Accessible
  - » Anyone May Request "Certified Copy"





- Image Redaction Request for Proposals
  - » Request For Information Published 9.26.08
  - » Redaction Project Assumptions and Guidelines Adopted 11.12.08
  - » RFP Scheduled for Approval 12.17.08
  - » Responses Expected Late January 2009 (Tentative)



# Next Steps

- Preparing Technical Plan
  - » New Image Repository (Public and Private)
  - » Reconfiguration of Database and Image Handling
  - » Integration with Redaction Services
  - » Disaster Recovery
  - » System Changes Required by ILR and Local Service Providers



# Next Steps

- Exploring Legislative Options
  - » Stakeholder Meetings on October 8 and November 25
  - » Definition of Personally Identifiable Information
    - SSN and Account Numbers
  - » Redaction Requirements Electronic Documents
    - Authority to Redact
    - Preserving Unaltered Records
  - » Documents NOT Included
    - Already Confidential
      - Vital Records
      - Military Discharge Records



#### Next Steps

- Exploring Legislative Options
  - » Open Access to Records In the Recorders Office
  - » "Commercially Reasonable" Redaction
    - Limitation of Liability
  - » Authorize Bulk Sale
    - Redacted Information Only
  - » Strengthen CLRIS Enabling Legislation
    - Policies, Procedures, Standards
    - Electronic Recording

#### Exploring Legislative Options

- » Resources for Redaction and System Changes
  - Subscription Service and/or Electronic Transaction Fee
  - No State Appropriation Request
- » Request Draft Study Bill
- » Prepare to Implement Upon Enactment



# Considerations

#### - Cost? High Level Estimates ...

- » Systematic Redaction
  - Florida \$0.0235 per image. Estimated 35 million images. \$800,000 - \$1,200,000
  - ◆RFP Pending.
- » Development Work for New Registration Security, Redaction Support, Image Migration
  - ABCV Draft Proposal
    - \$200K-\$250K
- » New "Clean" Image Repository and Related Activity (New Equipment, Configuration and Image Handling)
  - **\$250K**
