Iowa Land Title Association Key Points for Interim Committee Members Identity Theft Interim – 2 December 2008

- ✓ Iowa Land Title Association (Abstractors) oppose on-line land records
 - With records on-line, the out-of-state title insurance agents writing business on an Iowa property can sell a title policy that an Iowa abstractor cannot; the availability of on-line records enables these out-of-state agents to completely bypass doing business with ANY Iowa entity, e.g. abstractors and attorneys
- ✓ The bulk sale of data hurts Iowa's land title system and facilitates capital flight from the Staterun Title Guaranty program
- ✓ If Iowa Land Records is to continue operation, Iowa Land Title Association (Abstractors) favor a subscription-based system wherein the users who wish to benefit from the CONVENIENCE of on-line records pay the cost of building and maintaining the on-line database
 - Such a system should be secure in order to prevent unauthorized access to data
 - The system should be day-forward from the day the website was created historical documents contain much more personal information due to the lack of sensitivity to the use of Social Security Numbers prior to 2005
- ✓ Iowa Land Title Association (Abstractors) oppose charging a fee to EVERYONE who files a document to build and maintain an on-line database
- ✓ Iowa Land Title Association (Abstractors) support restricting access to on-line land records to those who have a legitimate business need to access such records (e.g. abstractors bankers and attorneys, all of whom deal with determining who has clear title to property)
