

Thomas R. Temple, R.Ph., M.S., Executive Vice President & CEO, Iowa Pharmacy Association

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Bio: Thomas R. Temple is the Executive Vice President and CEO of the Iowa Pharmacy Association (IPA), a position he has held since 1980. Mr. Temple received a B.S. degree in Biology from Northern Illinois University (1971), a B.S. degree in Pharmacy from the University of Illinois (1975) and a M.S. degree in Pharmacy Administration from the University of Iowa (1977). In addition to serving as chief executive officer of IPA, Mr. Temple also serves as CEO of the Iowa Pharmacy Foundation (IPF) and Pharmacy Network of Iowa (PNI) -- two subsidiary corporations of the Iowa Pharmacy Association.

Mr. Temple is a member of several professional organizations including the IPA, ASHP, APhA, the American Society of Association Executives (ASAE) and the National Council of State Pharmaceutical Association Executives (NCSPAEE). A past president of NCSPAEE, he has served as a Board member for Quality Assurance, Inc., the Pharmacy Marketing Group and Health Connect, and as a member of numerous professional committees including USP Membership Committee, the Medic Alert National Task Force, ACPE's CE Advisory Council, ACPE's Doctoral Fellowship Committee, the State Advisory Panel to the National Pharmacy Technician Certification Board and Advisory Committees for Drake University and the University of Iowa Colleges of Pharmacy. He has also served as a member of Pharmacy Advisory Boards for Upjohn, Glaxo, Merck, Mallinckrodt, and PCS.

The Smile Squad School Program provides education, oral health screenings, dental sealants and fluoride varnish to children in Polk County. Nancy received a Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene from Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Dr. Peter Damiano, DDS, MPH

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Bio: Peter Damiano, DDS, MPH is the Director of the Health Policy Research Program at the University of Iowa Public Policy Center and Professor, Department of Preventive and Community Dentistry at the College of Dentistry. He is a former Robert Wood Johnson Dental Health Services Research Scholar and HRSA Primary Care Policy Fellow. He is a graduate of the University of Iowa College of Dentistry (DDS) and UCLA School of Public Health (MPH). His principal area of research is health services research and includes studies of access to care, quality, cost and outcomes of care, particularly for primary care services. His research projects include studies of access to and utilization of care for underserved populations, program evaluation and health plan outcomes research. He incorporates oral health issues into his research as one aspect of primary care.

He has been the principal investigator for a number of studies for the Iowa Department of Human Services (IDHS) and Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) over past 16 years. For the IDHS, he has conducted studies evaluating the Iowa Medicaid

managed care and *hawk-i* programs, a study of the barriers to enrollment in the Medicaid and *hawk-i* programs and will soon begin an evaluation of the Iowa Care program. For IDPH, he is in the midst of the second study of the health and well-being of children and families in Iowa called the Iowa Child and Family Household Health Survey. He was the coordinator of the Healthy Iowa 2010 Oral Health Committee and former Chair of the State Dental Advisory Council. He provides care as a dentist to physically and mentally compromised patients in the College of Dentistry's Special Care Clinic.

Dr. David Johnson, DDS, MS

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Bio: David Johnsen received his DDS degree from the University of Michigan in 1970 and his MS in Pediatric Dentistry from the University of Iowa in 1973. He became Board certified in Pediatric Dentistry in 1978. Professor Johnsen has been on the faculties of West Virginia University from 1974-80, with the Outstanding Teacher Award, 1976; Case University from 1980-95, where he served as Department Chair, intermittently as Director of the Residency Program and as Interim Dean in 1993; and the University of Iowa from 1995 to the present, serving as Dean of Dentistry.

Professor Johnsen's research has focused in two main areas, both with federal funding: innervation of teeth as an indicator of capacity to transmit pain sensory impulses and early childhood caries/caries patterns in preschoolers. The latter area included demonstration projects or consulting nationally in the Women, Infant and Children's Program and the Head Start Program. He has also published on a variety of clinical and educational topics.

Professional service has included the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry Board of Directors, 1988-91, Child Health (legislative) Advocate, 1992-95, with the Distinguished Service Award in 1996. Dr. Johnsen received the Achievement Award from the Ohio Dental Association in 1992. He served the American Dental Education Association Council of Deans Board, 1998-2001 and as ADEA President, 2002-03.

University Service has included election to Chair the Faculty Senate at Case University, 1994. At the University of Iowa he served as Chair of the Search for the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics CEO, 2002, as Co-Convener of the Health Sciences Policy Council, 2003-04, as Co-Chair of the University Task Force on Clinical/Translational Research in 2005-2006 and as Chair of the Nursing Dean Search in 2006.

Dr. Stacey Cyphert, PhD., University of Iowa

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Bio: Stacey T. Cyphert, Ph.D. is Special Advisor to the President of the University of Iowa for Health Sciences Government Relations, Special Advisor to the Dean of the Carver College of Medicine, and Senior Assistant Director of the University of Iowa

Hospitals and Clinics. He is a current member and former chair of the Medical Assistance Advisory Council, provided staff support to the Medical Assistance Crisis Intervention Team, and served on the Covering Kids Now Task Force, Iowa Plan Advisory Group and the Welfare Reform Advisory Group, among others.
